

THIS IS OUR FAITH

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

What is the essence of the Trinity? We explain it simply and say, "it is 3 persons in one God", then we continue..."it is impossible to understand!" Perhaps we can get a glimpse into the essence, power and uniqueness of the Trinity from the one accord, the one mind the three persons bring to this relationship, to *their* relationship. The three persons of the Trinity are of one accord Love. This love unites and is given its prominence in Jesus' being of one mind with the Father's will on Good Friday. Jesus says "Yes" to the Father's will by going to the cross for us. At every Mass we see the unity of the Trinity in the Eucharist, when Jesus again says "Yes" to the Father's will in the words of the consecration.

During the Eucharistic consecration at Mass, we hear "On the day before He was to suffer, He took bread in His holy and venerable hands and with eyes raised to heaven, to you, O God, His almighty Father giving You thanks He said the blessing, broke the bread and gave it to His disciples saying: "take this all of you and eat of it, for this is My Body which will be given up for you." In a similar way, when supper was ended, He took this precious chalice in His holy and venerable hands, and once more giving You thanks, He said the blessing and gave the chalice to His disciples saying: "take this all of you and drink from it for this is the chalice of My blood, the blood of the new and eternal covenant which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins, do this in memory of Me."

The Mass is not a passive activity in which we are meant to be mere observers, nor are we at Mass to be entertained. No, we are called to actively join our individual yes to that of Jesus' continuing "Yes "to the Father's will. The Trinity is a powerful model for all human beings, most especially for us Americans. Our national motto is "E Pluribus Unum" from the Latin "out of many one." The Trinity out of love and its one accord created, redeemed, and sanctifies mankind. Jesus calls us to join in the continuing work of the Trinity, as we fulfill the mission that God has given to each of us, to do His will here on earth. In The Name of the Father and The Son and The Holy Spirit. Amen.

Congratulations and God's many blessings to our clergy and religious who serve in our parish.

Dear Parishioners,

The Catholic Schools of our diocese need you to help us get an important message to NJ lawmakers by June 15. We are asking you to send an online message through Voters Voice today. Here are the details you need to know:

Ask State Budget and Appropriations members in your district to increase the ceiling for nonpublic school transportation from \$884 to \$1000. This could be done by moving funds, without increasing the overall Fiscal Year 2018 budget.



- Ask them also to restore funding for: (1) the Nonpublic School Security Aid Program, (2) the Nonpublic School Nursing Service Aid and (3) the Nonpublic School Technology Initiative.
- If your State legislators are not on one of the Budget Committees, ask them to urge their colleagues on the Committees to increase the transportation ceiling and restore the funding to nursing, technology and security. Such increases are greatly needed by nonpublic school children whose parents save the taxpayers of New Jersey a great deal of money every year.

- The Dioceses of Camden, Trenton and Metuchen are strongly impacted by the transportation issue and are rallying our families, our strongest advocates. Pray

That the Lord would protect all migrants and refugees, and that all those who work with people on the move would be free to serve.

Reflect

Christians are committed to caring for the vulnerable, and migrants and refugees are some of the most vulnerable. The Church has long sought to serve the unique needs of "people on the move," from providing for basic needs, to assisting with resettlement, to offering legal services to help newcomers navigate the system of their host country. In recent years, new laws and regulations have been proposed that have the effect of restricting the Church's ability to serve. Under one state law, even giving an undocumented person a ride to Mass could have been deemed a criminal offense. Furthermore, the new federal Administration has sought to drastically reduce the number of refugees admitted into the U.S., and has suspended the resettlement of refugees from countries where many people face violent persecution. The Church is called to serve the vulnerable, and we must remain steadfast in our commitment to solidarity with migrants and refugees.
