

## "Resisting Happiness"

WEEK 2

#### How do I find God?

This week Kelly takes on his spiritual journey with his spiritual director, John. John, a family friend, befriends Matthew when he is in his mid-teens and begins to ask him spiritual questions. At each of these questions Matthew meets resistance; some high-points in this journey follow:

I have a soul! John helps Matthew see that there is more to life that his physical and material side. John points out that Matthew has a soul that is meant for eternal life with God, and that just as he needs to nurture and develop his physical and mental capabilities, he needs to nurture and develop his spiritual side. You and I have a soul too!

**AHA Moment:** God calls Matthew to holiness. In his late teens Matthew has a personal Pentecost, coming of the Holy Spirit, when he realizes that God calls him and every man and women to holiness. *This includes you and me.* For the Catholic Church and Matthew, God calls everyone to be holy. Matthew says this is God calling us to be the "Best Version of Ourselves!

**Holiness leads to Happiness:** Matthew says "when I did something that I knew was God's will, something that would clearly help me become a better version of myself, I was filled with joy. When I did something that I knew was wrong or was clearly not good for me, that joy began to evaporate."

**How to live out this holiness?** Some suggestions John makes to Matthew:

- Spend 10 minutes speak to God about your day, first thing in the morning.
- \* Read the Bible: Read a chapter a day in the New Testament. Pick out a word or phrase that speaks to your heart, and ask God what he is saying to you in it. The people in the bible made decisions either on faith or fear. Reading God's word we are called to a life of hope and trust in God
- Turn each hour of the day into prayer: But I'm not a priest or nun, how do I do this? Saint Paul tells us to "pray without ceasing" 1Thes. 5:17. Kelly says "As Christians we are called to transform every activity in our lives with prayer, this is how we become the best version of ourselves and live holy lives."

Work is one of the primary tools God has given us to grow in virtue and through virtue we become the best version of ourselves and lead a holy life. He stresses that Catholicism is an incredibly practical religion and that we are called to make our work a prayer. ► Matthew suggests that at the beginning of each hour, we set an alarm and decide who we are praying for during this time. Then we let our work be our prayer. This will constantly remind us we are in the presence of God.

**God's Mind?** By doing these things Kelly says we will align our hearts and minds with God and open the doors to his grace to help us do His will.
