## Want the Rest Lent Ever?

Dynamic Catholic continues its Best Lent Ever this year. Besides giving up something for Lent, Dynamic Catholic again recommends doing something to deepen your spiritual life and to increase your involvement with God and neighbor. Join your fellow parishioners and sign up for the Best Lent Ever at www.dynamiccatholic.com. You will receive a daily email meditation for each day of Lent.

This year the Lenten messages will center on Matthew Kelly's book, Resisting Happiness. Our Parish Pastoral Council gave copies of this book out at Christmas in anticipation of our reading it together as a parish for Lent. The parish Religious Education/ Faith Formation office will also offer discussion groups twice a week revolving around the book. The book is divided into 37 short chapters which easily correspond to the almost 40 days of Lent as a daily meditation.

During these first four days of Lent, Matthew Kelly introduces us to the concept of Resistance in our lives. For Kelly, Resistance is the factor that stops you from doing something you know is good for you or inclines you to do something you know is not good for you, and everything in between.

Kelly recounts his own story of how Resistance inhibited his becoming the best version of himself, and he points out how every human being has experienced Resistance when trying to achieve their goals. But this is not a self-help book for the material world only. Matthew Kelly also presents the spiritual side to self-improvement. He notes and stresses that Resistance stands between you and the person God created you to be, and therefore Resistance stands between you and happiness!

Kelly reminds us that God wants us to be happy even more than we want to be happy. He reminds us that life is messy, but that Our Lord, Jesus, entered directly into this messy life to show us how to make it holy and to show us the way to happiness.

Kelly plans to use examples from his own life to show us how to



combat Resistance: fear. doubt, laziness, procrastination, self-loathing, and all the other wavs Resistance manifests itself in our lives. Kelly wants us to become the best version of ourselves that God wants us to be. His first hint is that when Resistance hits us that we should take one small step. Don't let discouragement set in, take one small step one small action and we will begin to fill up with hope again and with hope comes the capacity to act, to change, to move forward.
