SACRED HEART SOCIAL CONCERNS

January-March 2017 — Quarterly Report

Thank you and God bless you for your continued support to those in need from our parish family. Your generosity allows us to continue to serve the most needy and to be a living example of Mercy.

With your gifts we were able to assist, on a monthly basis, 29 families with food and financial aid. During the past quarter our food pantry has been well stocked with continuous donations of food from parishioners and other residents (464 bags). We distributed 500 bags of food to families in need. We assisted families with financial help (\$6,440.00), and over \$1,815.00 in gift cards for perishable food, clothing, and other personal needs. Please note:

- Social Concerns Ministry also supported the God's Special People's luncheon in February.
- Thank you to Holy Savior Academy's Brownie Troop 65402 for over 40 bags of food.
- Reimbursements from Catholic Charities: \$1500.00. (Part of your donations to the Bishop's Annual Appeal and Catholic Charities does come back to the parish)

THIS IS OUR FAITH

Stewardship of Time and Talent

— GOD'S YARDSTICK —

This weekend we have our parish ministries fair – allowing you to identify how you might use your time and talents for the glory of God and the well-being of our parish, world, and neighbor.

God's plan for using our time and talents is made clear in two parts of St. Matthew's Gospel. Ironically, one is called the "Parable of the Talents", MT 25:14-30. Briefly, a man goes on a journey. He calls in three of his servants and gives them different amounts of money, the denomination just happens to be called a Talent (75 pounds of silver). To one servant he gives five talents. to another two, and to the third, one talent. The two servants who receive the five and two talents invest them and double the money. When the master returns he commends them for being faithful in small matters and lets them keep the money. But the servant who received the one talent buried it. The master returns and this servant gives him the one talent back, and says I was afraid of using it since I did not want to lose it. Jesus has the master say to that servant, "You wicked, lazy servant! So you knew that I harvest where I did not plant and gather where I did not scatter? Should you not then have put my money in the bank so that I could have it back with interest on my return? Now then! Take the talent from him and give it to the one with ten. For to everyone who has, more will be given and he will grow rich; but from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away."

Wow, Jesus made His point in that parable, but the gospel writer, just to make clear that God wants us to use the gifts He has given us for his glory and service to our neighbor and world, places "The Judgment of the Nations" in the very next section of Matthew's gospel, 25:31-46. There Jesus says "When the Son of

Man comes in His glory ... He will place the sheep on His right and the goats on His left. Then the king will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink" etc. "Then He will say to those on His left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his



angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger, or naked or ill or in prison and you did not care for me, Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for Me.' And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

Jesus is calling and leading; Lord, help us to trust and follow You.


