THIS IS OUR FAITH

Year of Consecrated Life Concludes

In 2013, Pope Francis proclaimed a **Year of Consecrated Life** was to begin on November 29, 2014 (the First Sunday in Advent) and conclude on February 2, 2016. In the Diocese of Metuchen, the year will conclude this November 22. The year 2014 was chosen as it was the 50th anniversary of the Vatican II document, *Perfectae Caritatis*, a decree on religious life that reformed and transformed religious life. The purpose of the year, as stated by the Vatican, was to, "make a grateful remembrance of the recent past" while embracing "the future with hope."

To consecrate something means to set it aside or devote it to a holy purpose. When a man or woman decides to accept Christ's

invitation to leave everything and follow Him in a more radical way, they make vows to live like Jesus in poverty, chastity, and obedience. In a special Mass they make this commitment, much like a married couple exchanges their vows on their wedding day. They promise Christ that they will live the rest of their lives dedicated exclusively to Him. These vows help them



to live simply, to be more open with God, and to depend totally on Him. This Year honored the men and women in consecrated life, and was also a year of prayer for vocations to religious life.

The Year of Consecrated Life also coincided with our own parish celebrations of the 50th Anniversary of the Dedication of the new Church. The Church of the Sacred Heart has had consecrated religious Sisters serving in ministry since 1939. There are few Churches today that can claim a religious presence for 76 years and counting!

As we come to the conclusion of this Year of Consecrated Life and to the Church Jubilee Year, the words of Pope John Paul II, spoken to religious in the exhortation, *Vita Consecrata*, seems a fitting conclusion for both.

"You have not only a glorious history to remember and to recount, but also a great history still to be accomplished! Look to the future, where the Spirit is sending you in order to do even greater things."




