THIS IS OUR FAITH

This is Our Church

As we approach our 50th Jubilee Anniversary of our Church building next weekend, November 21, we offer some interesting Church facts:

- † At the turn of the 20th century, there were twenty Catholic families living in South Plainfield. Today, the Church of the Sacred Heart has 2,122 parish families registered.
- † We began as a mission Church to St. John the Evangelist Church in Dunellen. On August 22, 1905 we were officially incorporated as "The Church of the Sacred Heart." In 1909 we were raised to the status of a parish, with Rev. John F. Baldwin appointed as the first pastor. Rev. John P. Alvarado is the 12th pastor. Fr. Baldwin was the longest serving pastor (20 years) and Fr. Sico the second longest serving with 17 years.
- † The Church is built of buff-colored brick and Indiana cut limestone in a modified Gothic design.
- † The vestibule of the Church (the main entrance) is finished with terrazzo floors and marble walls.
- The Sanctuary floors are terrazzo and the main altar and the two side altars are of carved marble imported from Italy. The communion rail is also made of marble.
- † The stained glass windows on the Sacred Heart side of the Church, depict the Seven Sacraments; the stained glass windows on the Blessed Mother side depict the Seven Joys of the Blessed Mother.
- † In the Sanctuary, there are eight windows (which can be difficult to see) four on each side. The Sacristy side illustrates the Four Evangelists Matthew, Mark, Luke and John; on the opposite side the four windows are of the four Latin Doctors of the Church St. Augustine, St. Ambrose, St. Gregory and St. Jerome.
- The large rose-window above the arched doorway has Jesus, the Lamb of God, at its center, surrounded by the twelve Apostles.

But the greatest treasure of the Church is YOU, our parishioners! We hope to see you at the 5:00PM Mass, next weekend, November 21, with Bishop Bootkoski presiding. The celebration continues with a complimentary dinner following the Mass, in the school cafeteria.

PAPAL QUOTE AND CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING - "Increasing reliance on the death penalty diminishes us and is a sign of growing disrespect for human life. We cannot overcome crime by simply executing criminals, nor can we restore the lives of the innocent by ending the lives of those convicted of their murders. Note: On *December 17, 2007*, New Jersey became the 14th state without a death penalty and the first state to abolish it by legislative action rather than by judicial decision. The death penalty is currently illegal in 19 States, including DC.




