



THIS IS OUR FAITH

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

The solemnity of *Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe,* is one of the newest on the Church's calendar. It was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI, and is celebrated on the last Sunday of the Church year. The title, King of the Universe, is an aspect of Jesus' identity that is rooted in Scripture and is reflected in all three of our Sunday readings. (Daniel, Revelation and the Gospel of John)

This day marks the end of the liturgical year with the new liturgical year beginning next weekend, the first Sunday in Advent. (Similar to the end of the secular year on December 31, and the beginning of the new year on January 1.) The Church keeps track of time by the events in the life of Christ. We end the year with his triumphant title - King of the Universe - and begin the New Year with Advent awaiting the birth of Christ, God made flesh.



May Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, bless our Sacred Heart parish family and our world with peace, as we stand on the threshold of another New Church Year.

The Church of the Sacred Heart fact: The name of "Jesus" was never a part of our church/parish title. When we were incorporated in 1905 and became *The Church of the Sacred Heart*. There are other churches in our diocese that bear the name The Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our parish title is unique among them.

PAPAL QUOTE AND CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING -

"Today's liturgy invites us to fix our gaze on Christ, the King of the Universe. The beautiful prayer of the Preface reminds us that his kingdom is "a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace". The readings we have listened to show us how Jesus established his kingdom; how he brings it about in history; and what he now asks of us." (Pope Francis, Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, homily, Nov. 23, 2014)

HOW CAN WE HELP SYRIAN REFUGEES?

There is an "only one toothbrush" campaign that we can take part in. This sounds like a little thing, but it is something we can easily do. This toothbrush collection is being organized by the company *Verasoni Worldwide*. Their goal is to deliver 100,000 toothbrushes to the Syrian refuges in Germany. They are currently working with local NGO's (non-governmental organizations) to distribute the toothbrushes to the refugees once they arrive in Germany. 


