BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on **the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM** in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. Please note that we can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

AED IN CHURCH - An Automated External Defibrillator

(AED) is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and ventricular tachycardia in a patient, and is able to treat them through defibrillation allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm. We have purchased & installed an AED in church to assist in emergency medical situations. The AED is door-mounted next to the St. Joseph statue at the front of the church.



In the Catholic Church, Advent is a period of preparation extending for four Sundays before Christmas. The word *Advent* comes from the Latin *advenio*, "to come to," and refers to the coming of Christ. This brings us, ultimately, to our celebration of Christ's birth at Christmas; but initially, to the coming of Christ in our lives through grace and the Sacrament of the Eucharist and to His Second Coming at the end of time. Our preparations, therefore, should have all three elements in mind. We need to prepare our souls to receive Christ worthily.

Advent has traditionally been known as a "little Lent." As in Lent, Advent should be marked by increased prayer, fasting, and good works. While the Western Church no longer has a set requirement for fasting during Advent, the Eastern Church, both Catholic and Orthodox, continues to observe what is known as Philip's Fast, from November 15 until Christmas.

Traditionally, all great feasts have been preceded by a time of fasting, making the feast itself more joyful. Sadly, Advent today has been supplanted by "the Christmas shopping season," so that by Christmas Day, many people no longer enjoy the feast. The season of Advent typically begins with the Sunday nearest to the feast of St. Andrew the Apostle (30 November) and embraces four Sundays. The first Sunday may be as early as 27 November, leaving Advent with twenty-eight days, or as late as 3 December, giving the season only twenty-one days.

The Symbols of Advent

In its symbolism, the Church continues to stress the penitential and preparatory nature of Advent. As during Lent, the liturgical color is purple, and the Gloria ("Glory to God") is omitted during Mass. The Third Sunday of Advent is known as *Gaudete Sunday* and the priest can wear



rose-colored vestments. As on *Laetare Sunday* during Lent, this exception is designed to encourage us to

continue our prayer and fasting, because we can see that Advent is more than halfway over.

Other practices, beside the penitential ones noted above, associated with

Advent include keeping an Advent Calendar, lighting the Advent Wreath, praying an Advent daily devotional, as well as other ways of preparing for Christmas, such as placing Christmas decorations, writing Christmas cards, setting the Christmas Crèche and the Jesse Tree.


