

### REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

SUSTAINABILITY TIP: Myth: It uses less energy to boil water if you start with hot water form the tap. Truth: It uses the same amount of energy regardless of where the energy is from. If the water heater preheats it, you pay for that energy as well as any losses in the pipes and heater itself. TIP: Water boils faster in a covered pot and uses less energy. Use the least amount of water you can get away with.

## THIS IS OUR FAITH

### THE NEW PROCEDURE FOR ANNULMENTS

On September 8 of this year, Pope Francis issued a document, *Mitis ludex Dominus Jesus* (The Lord Jesus, Clement Judge) that will reform the annulment process. These reforms will go into effect December 8, 2015. This column will summarize key changes. The official statement regarding the nullity process can be found on the diocesan website – <a href="https://www.churchofthesacredheart.net">www.churchofthesacredheart.net</a>

First, the indissolubility of the Sacrament has <u>not</u> changed. Marriage was, and is, a permanent, sacred union. An annulment is an investigative process whereby the church determines that the marriage was never a Sacrament from the beginning. Certain conditions existed BEFORE the marriage took place that prevented a Sacramental union from occurring. For example, a lack of free will (getting married for citizenship purposes, pressure from family and friends, etc.) lack of psychological maturity, never intending to be faithful, and so on. An annulment does not have any bearing on the children born to that union.

So, how has the annulment process changed? Two key changes are:

- 1. The two Tribunal rule. A Tribunal is a Church court, under the direction of the Bishop, composed of specially trained priests, religious and laity that investigates a marriage to determine if there are grounds for an annulment. Previously, an annulment had to have two affirmative decisions one from our Diocese and then the case would be sent to the Tribunal of the Archdiocese of Newark for their decision. If both Tribunals agreed, the annulment was granted. Under the reforms, only one tribunal is needed to examine the marriage and declare a marriage null or affirm the Sacramentality of the marriage. In our case that would be the Tribunal of the Diocese of Metuchen. This will be a great savings in time.
- 2. Certain cases can now be decided directly by the diocesan bishop through an expedited process. The evidence presented for the annulment must be abundant and clear cut, and *both* parties in agreement that their marriage lacked the conditions for a Sacramental union. (For an annulment, only one of the spouses needs to start the process. He/she does not need the consent or the cooperation of their former spouse. This is still the case. However, for the expedited process, both parties need to be involved.

All of the annulment reforms are internal in nature, in other words involving the workings of the Tribunal AFTER the appropriate paperwork has been received from the individual seeking the annulment. The Tribunal can be contacted at: 732-562-1990 ext.1200 with any questions you may have. Fr. John and Sr. Kathleen are also here to assist you in this process.

PAPAL QUOTE AND CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING - In the Catholic tradition, responsible citizenship is a Virtue. Participation in the political process is a moral obligation. All believers are called to faithful citizenship, to become informed, active and responsible participants in the political process. 


