GIFTS FROM BETHLEHEM

Olivewood Handcrafted from the Holy Land

A TRADITIONAL ART AND LIVELIHOOD FOR HOLY LAND CHRISTIANS

The handicrafts trade evolved as a cultural tradition of Christians in the Holy Land for centuries. This indigenous form of art has since become an industry of great importance to the local people of the Holy Land who rely on it for livelihood, and to Christian pilgrims from all around the world whose holy pilgrimage can be memorialized for a lifetime in cherished olive wood or mother of pearl souvenirs. The olive wood carving market is the major source of income in the Bethlehem area. More than 65% of the income of the community in Bethlehem comes from this work.

In recent years, however, the holy crafts trade has suffered many hardships due to social and economical pressures. Because of a sharp fall in tourism and also as a result of diminishing numbers of craftsmen who leave their traditional trade and emigrate due to the difficult conditions in the homeland, the Holy Land handicraft market is facing serious danger, and so is the Christian community in the Land. Sixty-five years ago the Christians represented more than 28% of the total population in the Holy Land, today they are less than 1.5%. The loss of Christians in the land of Christianity's birth will represent a tragedy of immeasurable proportions for the billions of Christians worldwide.

Thank you for your vital support for a Christian tradition and in protecting this very important culture and industry.



PARISH MEMBERSHIP: Any new family who has moved into the parish area and adult children 18 years of age and older, are invited to register as a parishioner. The definition of an active parishioner is: One registered, attending Mass weekly and contributing to the support to the church. There is a (3) month minimum registration requirement before registering for a baptism or requesting letters of eligibility/sponsorship certificates.

SPONSOR LETTERS - Canon (Church) Law mandates that a Godparent for Baptism and a Sponsor for Confirmation be an active, Confirmed Catholic. An active Catholic is a parishioner who is registered, attends Mass weekly, contributes to the support of the Church, is in a valid Catholic marriage (an individual married civilly by a judge, mayor, or divorced and remarried without an annulment is not eligible to act as a sponsor) and publicly leads a life compatible with Church teaching. We can only write *Letters of Eligibility* for parishioners who meet these criteria.

BAPTISM/SPONSORSHIP CLASS - Parents and godparents are required to attend one session before the child's baptism date can be confirmed. Sessions are held on the 1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00PM in the Parish Center - 3rd floor. (Adults only - please, no infants or children.) Registration is required. Time, Talents, Treasures!

Recall today's scriptures? God was speaking to you and me in it; directly to each one of us. That's right! Scripture is the inspired word of God. Scripture itself tells us that it is there to guide us, "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path. I make a solemn vow to observe your righteous judgments" — Psalm 119: 105-106. In 2 Timothy, Scripture speaks to us again, saying "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness,"

In the Gospel today, Jesus clearly tells us what happens to people who seem to use their wealth for themselves and forget others. *"There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. And lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table. Dogs even used to come and lick his sores. When the poor man died, he was carried away by angels to the bosom of Abraham." When the rich man dies he ends up in torment in the afterlife.*

According to the parable, the rich man is in torment because he missuses his wealth. We know this because the rich man asks God to send Lazarus to his five brothers so that they will not end in this place of torment. *"Then I beg you, father (Abraham), send him to my father's house, for I have five brothers, so that he may warn them, lest they too come to this place of torment."* But Abraham replied, *"They have Moses and the prophets. Let them listen to them."*

So what did the prophets have to say? What would the rich man's brothers have found out, what would the rich man have found out if they each had listened to the prophets? We have only to look at the first reading from the prophet Amos to find out. Here the Lord bemoans the way the wealthy are living in Israel, while the poor who make up the vast majority of the community are "collapsing" And to the well-off the prophet Amos, inspired by the Lord said: *"Therefore, now they shall be the first to go into exile, and their wanton revelry shall be done away with."*

It's easy to think to ourselves: Jesus is not speaking to me. I am not rich. But material wealth is all relative. You do have more than someone else, and the Lord calls you to use that wealth in service to others. We must remember that all we have is a gift from God. And Jesus calls us to be generous with all the gifts he has given us, all of our time, talents and treasures.


In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus can't make this any clearer, He says: "Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? When did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?' And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.'...Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels" ... because what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.' - Mt 25:34-41, 45.

Remember, "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness." Whoever has ears ought to hear. — Mt11:15
