ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS & CONFIRMATION SPONSORS

In order for someone to act as a Godparent or a Sponsor for Confirmation, they must have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. If they are married, it must have been married in a Catholic Church or in a ceremony recognized by the Catholic Church. Godparents and Sponsors must also obtain a Letter of Eligibility from their parishes indicating that they are attending Mass on a regular basis and that they fulfill all requirements.

Handling Life's Tensions

The seasons of our lives are times that let us know all is not perfect or complete. In the midst of our season of "ordinary times" we recognize that although we are unique in the way we work out our relationship with God, our lives are ordinary in that many of the tensions within ourselves are shared by most people: weakness and hope, failure and growth, good and evil. What binds us together as a community of believers is the effort to seek out God and do his will. Many people don't recognize that the hunger they feel and their sense of incompleteness, can only be satisfied through their relationship with God. Is there someone in your life who is seeking God and a faith community that will help them in that search? Invite them to come and hear more about the catholic faith at an RCIA Inquiry session.

These sessions DO NOT assume a commitment to join the Catholic Church, but instead are an opportunity to ask questions about God, Jesus, and the Catholic Faith. Inquiry sessions are for those who wish to explore, inquire, and search for ways to grow in relationship with God. All who are unbaptized, baptized in another faith denomination, or baptized Catholic but have not received Eucharist or Confirmation are invited.
