A MESSAGE FROM FR. JERRY

St. Kateri Tekakwitha Parish was officially proclaimed on Tuesday, July 14th, 2015. The Bishop's letter reads in part: "After consultation among the faithful and having received formal request of the same from the parish's pastor that was inspired by the parish's ministry and outreach to Native Americans living in the Sisseton area, and in recognition of the life of humility and devotion to Jesus, the Cross and the Most Holy Eucharist that Kateri Tekakwitha bears witness to, and in honor of her recent canonization, I hereby decree that Saint Catherine Parish in Sisseton, South Dakota be renamed Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Parish." Around 100 people participated in the liturgy and dinner. A new sculpture of Saint Kateri was blessed by the bishop. The sculpture was created by artist, Kaye Guerin Marks and the foundry man, Jon Moeller. Following dinner, Deacon Chet Cordell, a co-director of Native American Ministry in the diocese presented the parish with a print showing Saint Katharine Drexel with a Native American woman and symbols of the light of faith coming to Native American peoples. Alvah Quinn presented Bishop Swain with a beautifully beaded cross on behalf of the Parish. Fr. Ranek presented Ruth Ellis with a replica of the cross held by St. Kateri in the new sculpture. We are grateful to Bishop Swain and ask the prayers of St. Kateri that this re-naming of the parish in her honor may be a blessing that will yield much fruit over time.

RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is the process by which an adult prepares for joining the Catholic Church. Lately, in addition to preparing one candidate, I have had requests from two other adults who wish to prepare for Baptism. The new "class" will begin yet this summer. Any others who wish to participate in these sessions, either as candidates or to learn more about the faith, are asked to call the Parish Office to register. The schedule will be determined for how it works best for the participants.

<u>A Grief Retreat</u>, a follow-up to the "Grieving the Loss of a Loved One" session, put on by Dr. Marcie Moran of Catholic Family Services, will be held on August 1st at City Hall, 10am-3pm. This workshop is non-denominational and is meant to help bring greater understanding and healing to the grieving process. See inside for more details.
