#### From Your Pastor

Making Our Pilgrim Way to God ~ Processing towards Communion

Every year I enjoy the large number of processions that the Church gives us to mark our entry into the Season of Easter. On Passion (Palm) Sunday we relive the Lord's last entrance into Jerusalem by processing into church with blessed palm branches.



On Holy Thursday evening we conclude the Mass of the Lord's Supper by accompanying the Blessed Sacrament from the church to the altar of repose. On Good Friday the Lord's Cross is brought into the church by procession during the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion. Then, each of us present joins in a procession to approach the Crucifix and to venerate it reverently with a kiss. On Holy Saturday night, we begin the Easter Vigil, the solemn celebration of the Lord's Resurrection, by processing into the church with candles lighted from the great Paschal Candle, the symbol of the Risen Christ.

Processing during Sacred Liturgies is not an accidental affair. The Bishops' Secretariat for Divine Worship reminds us: "The Church understands ... every procession in liturgy as a sign of the pilgrim Church, the body of those who believe in Christ, on their way to the Heavenly Jerusalem. All our lives we who believe in Christ are moving in time toward that moment when we will be taken by death from this world and enter into the joy of the Lord for us.... When we move in procession, particularly the procession to receive the body and blood of Christ in Communion, we are a sign, a symbol of that pilgrim Church 'on the way'" (USCCB, 2002).

Most of our liturgies involve a procession from the back of the church down the center aisle. The Procession begins with the altar servers who carry incense, cross and candles, followed by the extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, the lectors, the deacon, other priests and the celebrant.

The Communion Procession has a special importance for Catholics: "The Communion Procession is an action of the Body of Christ. At Christ's invitation, extended by the priest acting in Christ's person: Blessed are those called to the supper of the lamb, the members of the community Move forward to share in the sacred meal, to receive the body and blood of Christ which is the sign and the source of their unity. In fact, Each time we move forward

together to receive the body and blood of the Lord, we join the countless ranks of all the baptized who have gone before us, our loved ones, the canonized and uncanonized saints down through the ages, who at their time in history formed a part of this mighty stream of believers" (USCCB, 2002).

How do I receive properly? In order to be able to receive Communion, you should not be conscious of grave sin (which requires the Sacrament of Penance); and you need to abstain from any food or drink, with the exception only of water and medicine, for at least the period of one hour before the time of Holy Communion. As you process to receive, there are three simple things that should be remembered.

First, the act of reverence one makes before receiving the body or the blood of Christ is a bow. This can be done as the person before you is receiving. Second, when the minister distributing Communion says "The Body of Christ," the person receiving says "Amen." Since the "Amen" is a necessary act of faith that this Is indeed the body of Christ, no other response like "Thank you" or greeting like "Happy Easter" is ever appropriate. Third, Communion may be received on the tongue or in the hand. If you receive on the tongue, please be sure to extend your tongue forward. If you receive in the hand, please be sure your hands are clean and that all sleeves are pulled clear of your palms. Then, resting one hand on the other (palms up) as if making a "throne" for Christ, the host will be laid in the palm of one hand so that the other hand can bring the Body of Christ to the mouth. Notice something important here: Holy Communion is a gift to be received; it is, therefore, never appropriate to reach out to take the host from the minister. We always receive the Lord humbly, unworthily.


