




We Are the Youth - WAY

Statement from Bishop Parkes concerning Ash Wednesday, February 14th:

Bishop Parkes has received questions regarding whether a dispensation from the discipline of fasting and abstinence will be granted on Ash Wednesday as it coincides with Valentine's Day. He is not inclined to grant a dispensation from this discipline for two main reasons:

1. Ash Wednesday is one of only tow days of the liturgical calendar (the other Good Friday) when fasting and abstinence are observed by Catholics and 2. for most people Valentine's Day is primarily a secular celebration rather than a religious observance.

Members of the faithful are encouraged to observe Valentine's Day with greater simplicity, or celebrate earlier.

El obispo no cree que se debe hacer una dispensa de esta disciplina especialmente por dos razones: 1. El Miércoles de Cenizas es uno de solamente dos días en el calendario litúrgico (el otro el el Viernes Santo) cuando los católicos tienen que hacer ayuno y abstinencia y 2, para la mayoría el Día de San Valentín es primordialmente una celebración secular más que una práctica religiosa.
