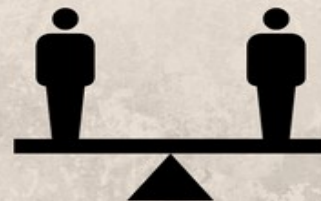

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300th Anniversary of the Death of the Great St. Louis de Montfort

April 28 marks the 300th anniversary of the death of St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort, one of the most important promoters of Marian devotion, the



Rosary, and consecration to Our Lady as a sure means of growing in grace and in love for Jesus her Son and our Lord.

It was de Montfort's method of consecration to Our Lady that St. John Paul II made and led to his motto: *Totus Tuus*.

In *Crossing the Threshold of Hope*, St. John Paul II wrote, "Thanks to St. Louis de Montfort, I came to understand that true devotion to the Mother of God is actually Christocentric, indeed, it is very profoundly rooted in the mystery of the Blessed Trinity, and the mysteries of the Incarnation and Redemption."

Works from St. Louis de Montfort:

Treatise of True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin,
The Secret of the Rosary, and *The Love of Eternal Wisdom*.

"It is through the most Blessed Virgin Mary that Jesus Christ came into the world, and it is also through her that he will reign in the world." St. Louis de Montfort

What is Marian consecration?

A Marian consecration flows from the grace of our Baptism, through which we were originally consecrated, or "set apart," for Jesus Christ and grafted into His life in the Church.



A Marian consecration is a further act of entrustment particularly to the heart of

Mary. In this gesture, we ask Mary to dispose us to the will of God as she herself was perfectly disposed.

Thank you to our catechists who have been working with our children all year, and with the retreat: Miss Shermila, Miss Catherine, Miss Emily and Miss Bianka

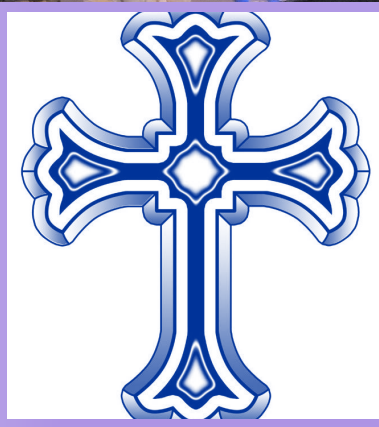

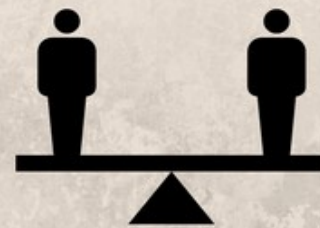
