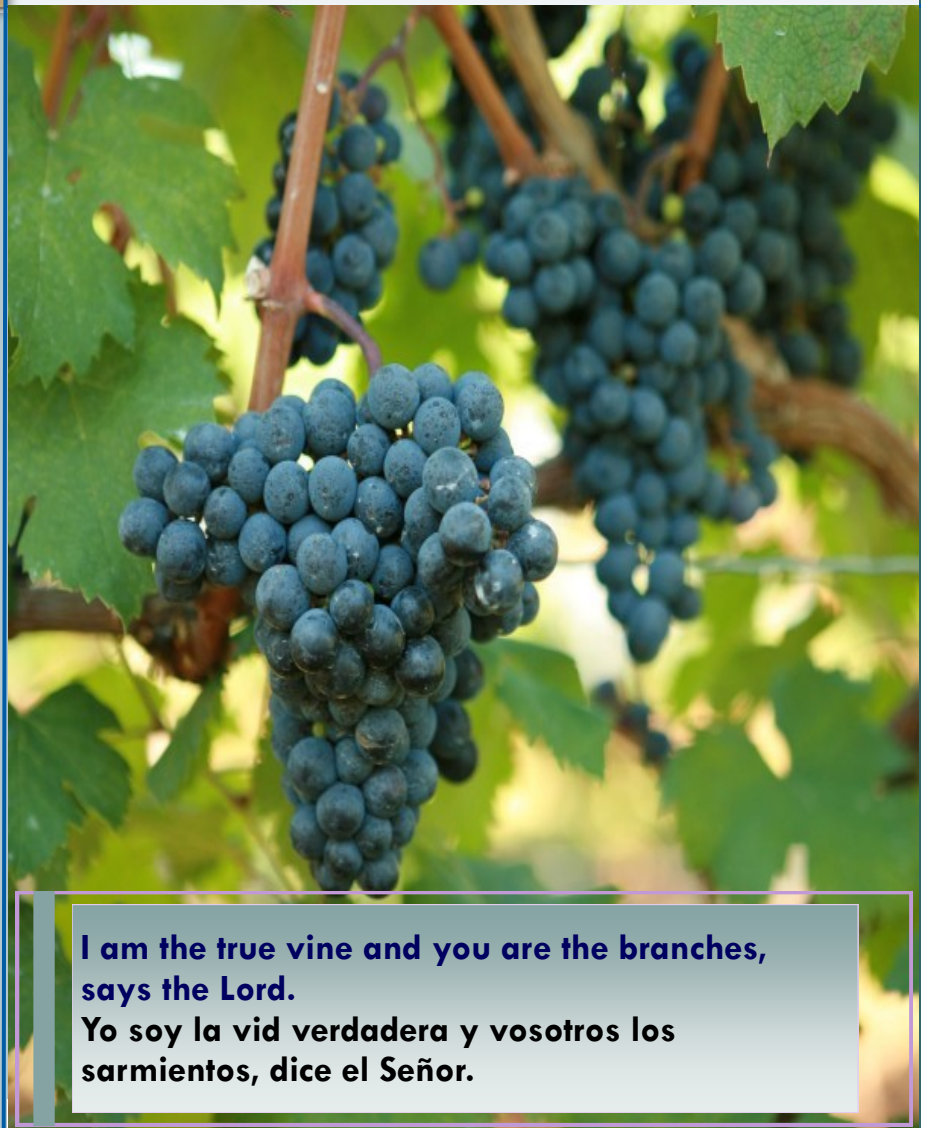

Bus Ministry: **Help Needed**



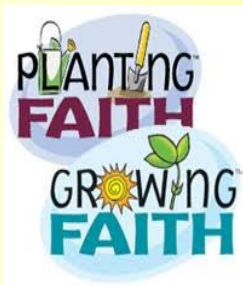
This ministry provides many of our parishioners the mobility to participate in weekly Masses, as well as many other parish events.
