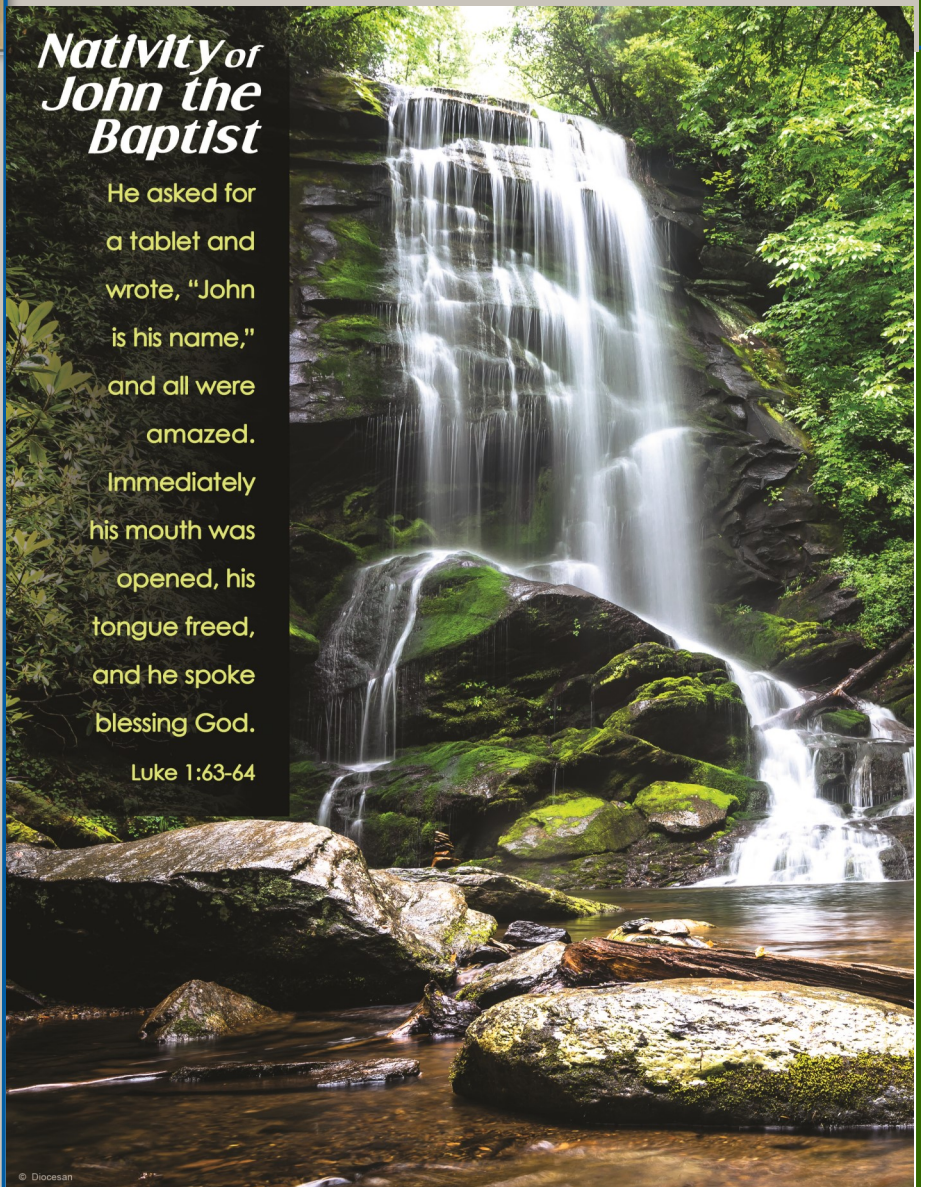

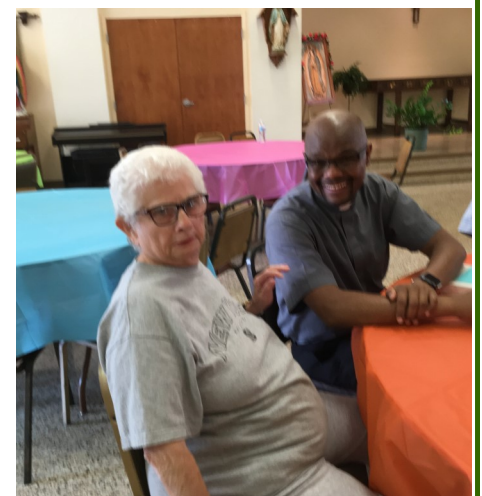
THANK YOU PADRE GEORGE

Annual Pastoral Appeal Update:

Our 2017 parish APA assessment of \$84,309 exceeds parishioner contributions of \$60,462.71 for the year. This shortfall of \$23,846.29 will have to be made up from ordinary parish revenue.

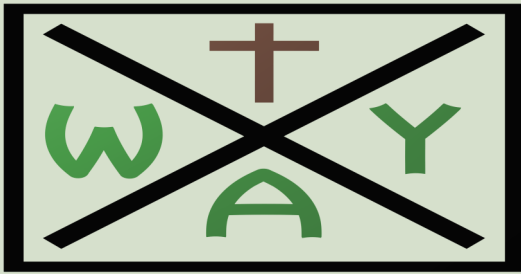
The USCCB has announced Religious Freedom Week from June 22-29th.

El costo es de \$330.00 por estudiante. Esto incluye la conferencia, el transporte, las comidas durante la conferencia, alojamiento y una camiseta.

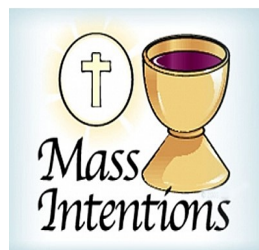
