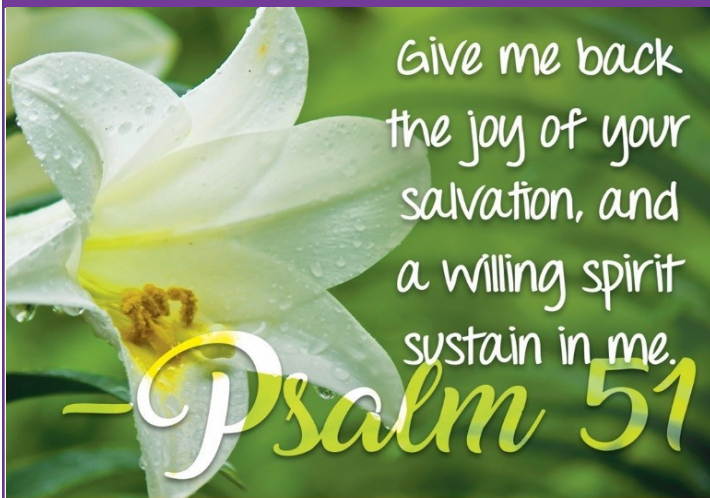

The farmer asked the man what he was cooking.



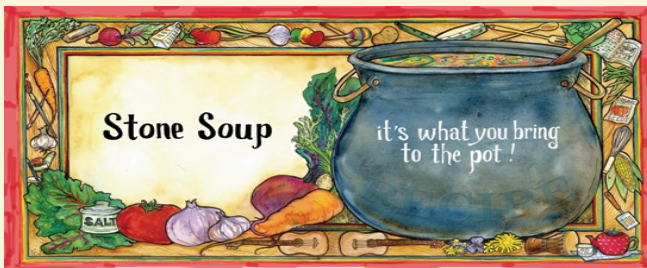
The man replied that he was making stone soup, and it was the most amazing soup in the world, but it could use more flavor. The farmer replied that he had some carrots that he could add.
