May is the Month of Our Mother Mary



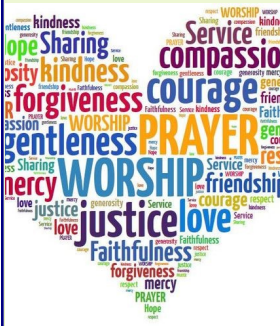
