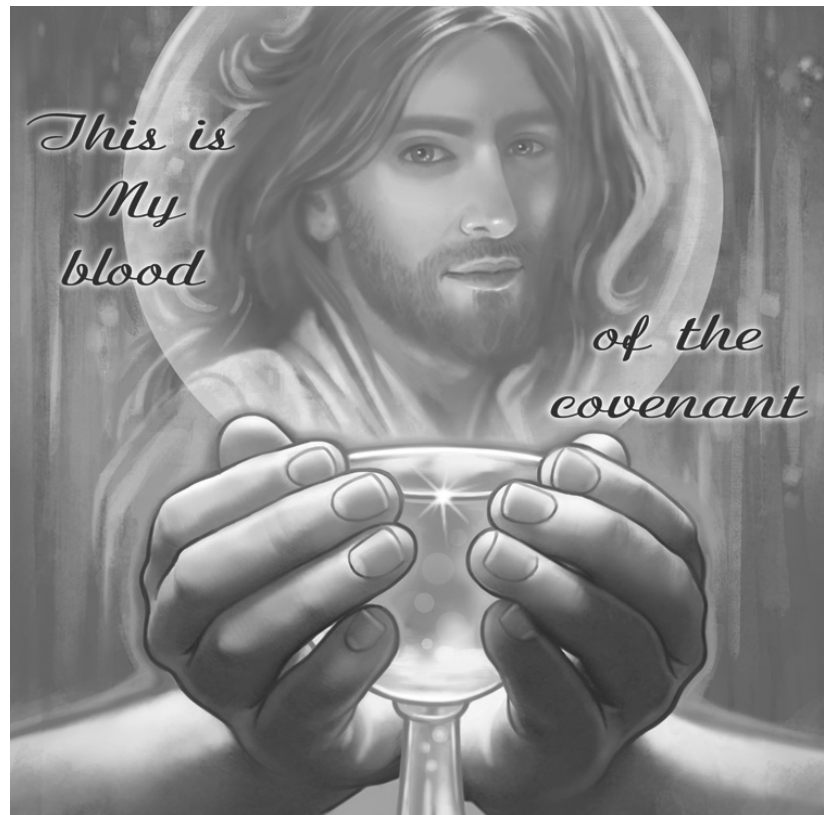

Mark 14:12-16, 22-26...Jesus offers his body and blood at the Last Supper.

Today's Gospel reading reminds us of what Eucharist is all about. It helps us to focus on the Last Supper, the final Passover meal Jesus shared with his friends. There we hear him say those familiar and astounding words: "This is my body. This is my blood."
