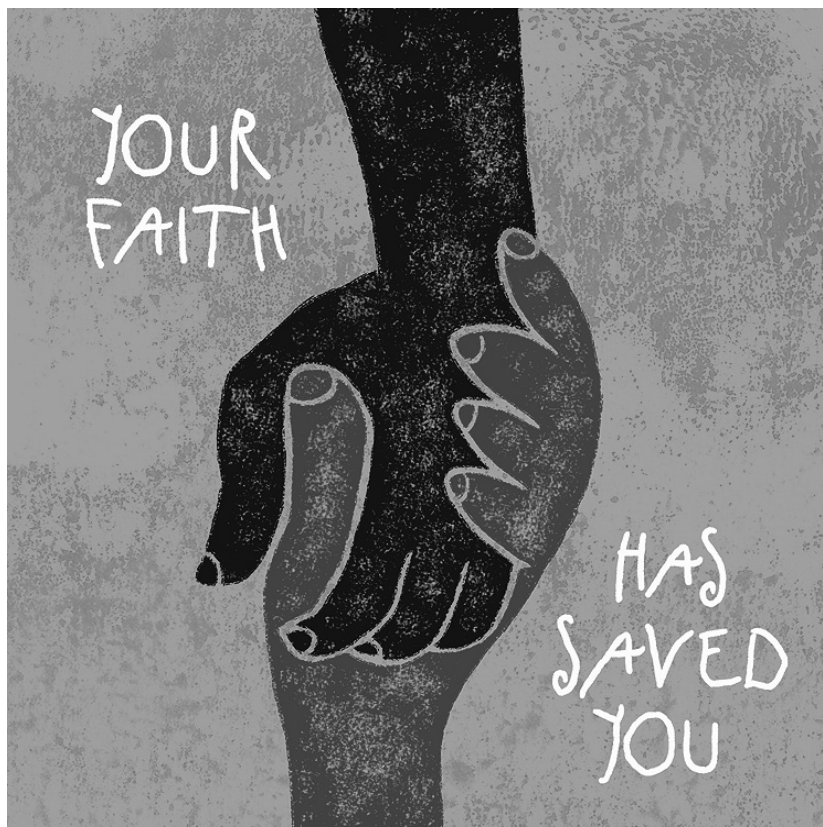

Mark 5:21-43...Jesus heals the hemorrhaging woman and raises Jairus' daughter.

Human beings have not always been generous or just, and they didn't always believe in an afterlife. Israel slowly came to understand that God is not the source of death and injustice, but of life and justice. We hear in the Book of Wisdom that God made creatures to live. And in today's Gospel, we see this demonstrated concretely in Jesus, who heals the dead daughter of Jairus and the hemorrhaging woman. We who follow Jesus and have been led to this powerful understanding are called to live as people of generosity, justice and life.
