## CATECHETICAL MINISTRY FAITH FORMATION & EDUCATION

### FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**Mark 6:7-13...The Twelve are sent out two by two to continue Jesus' mission.**

Today we reflect further on Jesus' prophetic ministry. In the Gospel so familiar to us, Jesus appoints others to carry on his mission. He sends out his disciples two by two, instructing them to travel humbly and simply. The disciples could be rejected, as was he and so many prophets before him. If this happened, they were to shake the dust from their feet and move on. Those who continue Jesus' mission are given his authority, but are not guaranteed an easy go of it - true for them and it is true for us.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD FOR CHILDREN (LTWC)** is a special celebration of the Word (during 10:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday mornings) created in accordance with the *Directory of Masses with Children*. It is "lectionary-based" for children ages 5-12 yrs. attending Mass with their parents/families. **NO REGISTRATION OR COST IS REQUIRED!** LITURGY OF THE WORD FOR CHILDREN is designed to include children in the liturgy and create a sense of belonging...to create a prayerful celebration simple enough that its message will be meaningful for them. The **Children's Liturgy of the Word** is meant to be a prayerful listening and response to Scripture...a means for the children's deeper involvement in the Mass because it is an offering on their level of understanding. In addition, it allows children to experience liturgy through ritual activity (*gestures, listening, responding, sharing, standing, processing*). After the *Gathering Song & Opening Prayer*, the children are dismissed (*with the morning's Leader(s)*) to participate in their own Liturgy of the Word (*in the Community Room near the Narthex*). They will hear the Gospel message for the Sunday, a homily at their own level, and create & offer their own Prayers of the Faithful. All of the readings, homilies, and prayers are geared toward children, so that they better understand and appreciate God's Word. This celebration will enable the children to discover and recognize themselves in the story proclaimed in the Gospel. When they make the discovery from within their experience, they can then thank, and praise, and bless God in their daily lives. The children return during the Presentation of Gifts to re-join their parents/families. **Liturgy of the Word for Children**, while focused on God's Presence in children's lives, allows respect for and understanding of children's loving relationship with God and a prayerfulness from the children's point of view. **(SPECIAL NOTE: Liturgy of the Word for Children essentially is worship, communal prayer.
