FROM THE PASTOR

“For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.” This line from St. Peter’s Second Letter reminds us that those who walked with our Lord in life and witnessed first hand his passion, death, and resurrection were aware that what they experienced would be difficult for others to accept. In fact, if one were trying to spread fanciful stories, it is likely that some of the details relayed in the Gospel would be different in order to increase its marketability to the people of the day. For instance, some say that a “cleverly devised” story would not include the fact that Mary Magdalene was the first recorded witness to the resurrection, but rather someone more notable and credible in that culture. But the facts are facts; and St Peter’s appeal has the ring of one who is sincerely committed to what he knows to be true.

Today we have the same dilemma as those who listened to St. Peter in person. We are presented with an event that seems incredible in our highly skeptical culture: God has come among us, and for our eternal communion with him, He died for our sake. We have more in common with St. Peter’s audience than we think. He was writing to a Church, probably in modern Turkey, that was straying from its original teaching because opponents had infiltrated the community and were openly twisting the doctrines that the apostles had passed on directly from Jesus. We don’t usually run into folks like that at Mass, but we all live in a world that has an apathetic attitude toward the Gospel. More alarming to St Peter was the lifestyle promoted by those scoffers that contradicted what our Lord taught us for our happiness as well as our salvation.

We can take confidence in the fact that not much has changed in 2000 years. God wants us to choose what will be the center of our lives. This is not to be difficult or challenging, but because for love to be love, it cannot be coerced or chosen out of advantage. Of course, that doesn’t mean to choose Christ is to oppose reason, but only to realize what it means that He rose from the dead that first Easter morning.

New life is the victor over death. The joy of Easter is that each of us has been offered that life, but we must trust the words of those who were its witness and guardian.

May Our Lord richly bless your Easter, and may you know His life at the center of yours!

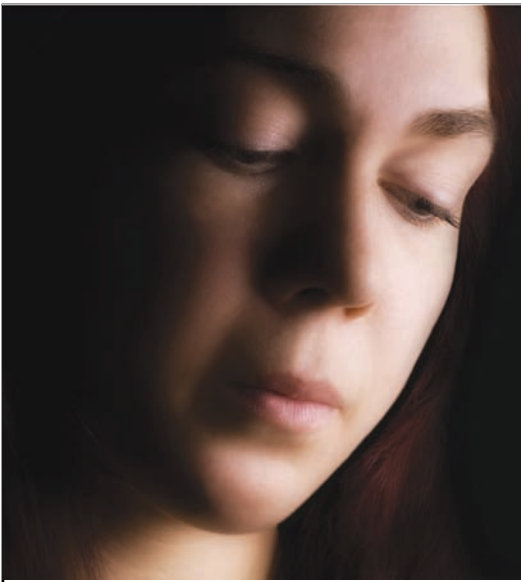

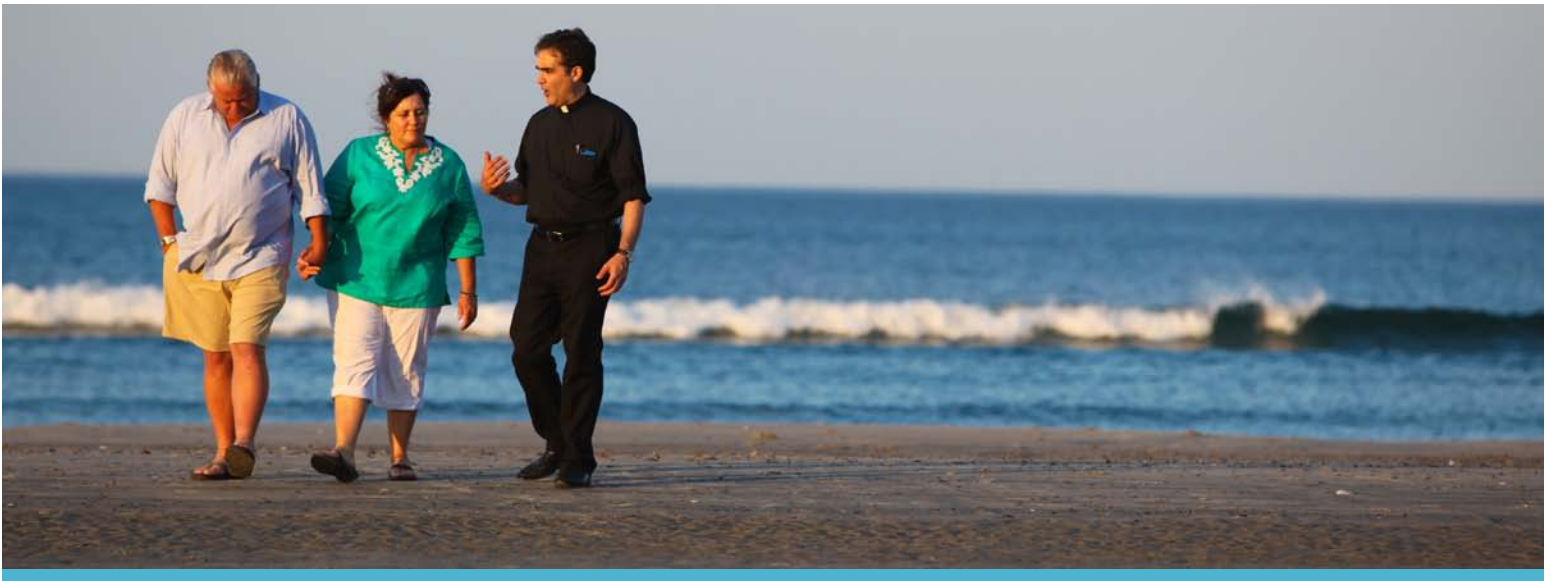

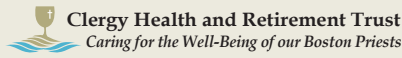
