JUDAS ISCARIOT
AND MATTHIAS

Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve apostles, betrayed Jesus at the first Easter. For thirty



pieces of silver, he told the Jewish authorities where they could find Jesus and arrest him secretly.

Thirty pieces of silver was the price of a slave in those days.

Judas later returned the money, but then killed himself. Because of that, the eleven remaining apostles selected another of the early disciples, to replace Judas. This was Matthias. We know very little about him.




