St. Anne's has received 60 gifts of \$20,160 (98% pledged) with \$373 remaining towards the \$20,533 goal.


St. Patrick's has \$20,950 pledged (63%) from 77 families with a remaining total of \$12,134 towards the mandated goal of \$33,084.
