A note from the Pastor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

The mission of the Church is not limited to announcing the Gospel and showing the way to Christ to the faithful. The Church is called also to accompany her children like a mother as they continue on their journey; pastors, then, are supposed to walk like shepherds side by side with their flock: with the young lambs, the older sheep, the healthy ones, the sick, and the dying.

In my desire to get acquainted with my parishioners, I have already visited some of the home bounds, and I am willing to continue. I am also visiting people who are facing health problems. Visiting the sick is one of the so-called *corporal* works of mercy. But it may be considered also a *spiritual* work of mercy. The sick person always needs counseling, instruction, comfort in afflictions, strength to bear sufferings, prayers, and the healing power of the sacraments. For this reason we priests like to know when someone is sick in our community, or is undergoing a dangerous and serious medical procedure. We may then bring him or her the necessary spiritual help.

When a priest visits the sick, he is always ready for administering the sacraments of penance and anointing; he can also bring Holy Communion and pray for healing and strength. It has always been a joy for me to spend some time with those who are suffering, because there I always witness the power of prayer and the presence of God. I have also observed that the company of the Church when death is imminent always brings comfort and peace: it allows the dying to reconcile with God and enter joyfully the door to eternal life.

What can you do when someone is sick in your family? Please remember that hospitals and other care giving institutions, even if they are assigned a chaplain, do not automatically call a priest when someone checks in! Patients, or their families, must personally notify where they are that they are Catholic, belong to a certain parish, and would like to contact their pastor. In emergency situations, however, when everybody is under extreme emotional and physical pressure, such notification may be set aside because of the needed medical assistance. Those are the circumstances, nevertheless, in which spiritual help is actually most vital! Do not expect a nurse or a doctor alert a priest for you!

If someone around is sick, in an emergency situation, or is getting closer to death, please call the parish rectory immediately, at any time, day and night; our main line – (201) 262-1122 – is always open. In the case nobody actually answers your call, please dial 9. As you hear the recording, and when prompted leave a brief message and a phone number (and remember to speak *clearly* and *slowly*). A priest will return your call shortly; do not hesitate to call again if you are not reached within 45 minutes.

As we have said so many times, we are here to help: please help us to help you!
