A note from the Pastor -

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Some thirty years ago a young man was walking on a street of his hometown, alone, not too happy about life, and definitely not interested anymore in going to church, disillusioned about what God might have actually done in his life. Another young man, a schoolmate, approached him and said that their church was offering some beautiful series of talks that could help all rediscover the meaning of life: it would not cost anything to give that a try. Thanks to that casual encounter, that young man is now typing these bulletin notes every week, as he ministers as pastor of the Church of the Assumption.

The best way – perhaps the only way – for anyone to become a true Christian is to meet another Christian. After encountering Jesus, the apostle Andrew – as we read in the Gospel of John – goes to his brother Peter and tells him, "We have found the Messiah!" We have met the Lord because others have met Him before we did, and then have shown us the way to Him.

We celebrate *Commissioning Sunday*, the day when I, as pastor, acknowledge all ministers of our church and bless them as they continue to work zealously for the benefit of our parishioners. This day not only reminds us that most of the activities normally held at Assumption have actually already started; it brings also to our reflection the urgency of announcing the Gospel to all in the very places they live at.

Many of those working in different ministries have met with me during the past weeks and shared concerns, ideas, suggestions, desires, and hopes. I wish to thank all of them for their invaluable helpful insights. They have brought me to realize that many people still need a personal encounter with the risen Lord; they need to hear that Christ himself wants to meet them in a special and powerful way. Now is the time to reach out to all of them. Now is the time to evangelize, yes, even going door-to-door!

This is why today, on *Commissioning Sunday*, I am asking you to "commission" me as well. Send me wherever there is a need to announce the Lord: to the sick, the homebound, the people who have become indifferent to the Word of God, those who are losing hope, to the lost sheep. Tell me where people need to receive the visit of a priest; let me know where we can bring the help of the Church! And if you wish, perhaps I could start with your own places. Maybe you desire to have your home blessed; maybe someone is presently living with you who cannot come to Mass; maybe your neighbor or best friend needs to hear some good news! I hope you'll be willing to help me in this important mission, so that I may become the good shepherd I am called to be.
