Our Pastor's Message

THINKING ABOUT TRADITIONS

Last summer, when I became pastor of the Catholic Community of Gloucester & Rockport, the local newspaper published a story about my devotion to various cultural and religious traditions. For the most part, the article was accurate. Since childhood, the traditions of the Church and the traditions of my family's Portuguese heritage have been a big part of my life. But as numerous seasonal feasts and festivals approach, we would be wise to pray about and reflect on the enduring value of tradition.

According to the Oxford English Dictionary, a tradition is a custom or practice that is passed from generation to generation. For me, this raises a simple but challenging question: Why? Why is this custom or that practice passed from one generation to the next? Why do we continue to carry on certain traditions and not others?

The dictionary's definition of tradition misses the point. Customs, practices, and traditions (cultural or religious) can only endure when they serve some good purpose; when they help us to grow in faith, hope, and love; when they build community and bring us closer together in a true spirit of prayer, fellowship, and service. If we continue a particular tradition for reasons of pride, fundraising, or blind devotion to the past, then we rob that tradition of its meaning and purpose. So, we owe it to our ancestors, ourselves, and our children to pass on not just rites and rituals, but also the meaning and value of every custom, practice, and tradition.

This coming week, for example, all are invited to the annual Crowning Feast of the Holy Spirit at Our Lady of Good Voyage Church. Each evening, we will gather as a community of faith to pray together, eat together, and build friendships under the guidance of God's Holy Spirit. This beautiful week-long feast does not belong to any one group, heritage, or organization. Rather, it belongs to all of God's people, to everyone in the Catholic Community of Gloucester & Rockport and beyond. It is a unique opportunity to come together in prayer – for the intercession of Our Lady and for the coming of the Holy Spirit into our hearts, homes, lives, and communities.

All are welcome to join me, the Holy Name Society, Our Lady's Guild, and all parishioners, friends, and guests of Our Lady of Good Voyage Parish and the Catholic Community of Gloucester & Rockport for this wonderful annual tradition in celebration of the coming of God's Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday. As the feast begins, let us pray that the Holy Spirit will inspire us with renewed zeal for prayer, fellowship, and service! And let us pray with one voice: Come, Holy Spirit! Come! Enkindle in us the fire of your love! Amen! Alleluia!

Fall Pilgrimage 2015

ASSISI PROJECT FALL PILGRIMAGE Only Two Spaces Remaining!

For the eighth consecutive year, Father Jim, Cliff Garvey, and the Assisi Project are sponsoring a week-long, small group pilgrimage to Assisi, Italy from October 30th through November 7th. Last year, a group of sixteen pilgrims literally walked in the footsteps of Saint Francis and Saint Clare of Assisi. This year, we will journey back to some of the world's most holy pilgrimage sites in Assisi, La Verna, and the Rieti Valley.

Each morning, our pilgrims will begin with breakfast, followed by Morning Prayer and Mass. Our Masses will be celebrated at the Church of San Damiano, the Porziuncola, and Basilicas of Saint Francis and Saint Clare. Each afternoon, the pilgrims will have the free time and guidance to explore the medieval city of Assisi at their own pace and to visit the countless churches, cafes, museums, and shops. Each evening, we will gather for supper, Evening Prayer, and a period of faith formation and fellowship.

As a fellowship of pilgrims, we will visit the historic Basilicas of Saint Francis and Saint Clare. Each of these great basilicas contains the tombs of the saints, holy relics, and priceless works of art. But these basilicas are also places for prayer, silent meditation, and worship. We will visit the Basilica of Saint Rufino, where Francis and Clare were baptized; the Church of Saint Damian, where the famous crucifix spoke to Francis; and the little chapel known as the Porziuncola, which is considered the home church of the worldwide Franciscan community.

In addition, we will spend leisurely afternoons in and around the Piazza del Comune, Assisi's city center, with its ancient Roman temple (now a Catholic church), sidewalk cafes, restaurants, and shops. The more adventurous will also have an opportunity to visit the Rocca Maggiore, the great medieval fortress with its stunning views of Assisi, the Spoleto Valley, and Mount Subasio.

Finally, we will travel to La Verna, the mountain sanctuary in Tuscany, where Saint Francis received the stigmata (five wounds of the Crucified Christ). At La Verna, we will celebrate Mass, enjoy a delicious lunch, and participate in the daily procession that commemorates how Saint Francis received the stigmata. We will also travel to Greccio (where Francis created the first live nativity scene) and to Fonte Columbo (where Francis wrote his rule under the guidance of an angel).

The cost of this extraordinary pilgrimage is just \$3,299 and includes air fare and associated fees; guest house accommodations, and ground transportation (except personal taxi services).
