## Father Sam's Message

In the Gospel this week, we see a familiar scene in which Jesus is challenged by the religious leaders of His time. The Pharisees notice Jesus' disciples eating without first washing their hands. They confront Jesus for permitting His disciples to do something that is forbidden by a long-standing custom. We hear, "The Pharisees and, in fact, all Jews, do not eat without carefully washing their hands." Jesus responds by citing a prophecy from Isaiah to show His critics "their hearts are far from" Him. Jesus is telling them they have not interiorized what He has revealed. These religious leaders are blinded because of their insistence on having things their own way or, as the Gospel says, because they "disregard God's commandments but cling to human tradition."

The Pharisees are often criticized for their strict adherence to the numerous laws of Jewish tradition. I propose their real obstacle to accepting Jesus' teaching is not their observance of the laws but has to do with their inability to be open to God's will, their unwillingness to see Jesus as God and obey Him. We can become hardened in our own ideas and opinions. In other words, we can "cling to human tradition" and "disregard" what God is asking of us. To avoid this fixation on our own thoughts, we desire to remain teachable. We continue to ask our Lord for the grace to humbly obey what He is asking of us as faithfully revealed in

the teachings of the Church. The Church does have our Lord Jesus' Word, and we want Him, through His Word, to penetrate ever more deeply into our hearts. To truly worship Him in our hearts, we need to keep our hearts pure as Christ admonishes us. He reminds us that from hearts that are fixed upon themselves and not God "come evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance, folly." We do not want to be like these Pharisees, whom Jesus judges as only paying "lip service" to God, but we want the humility and willingness to obey His Commandments in order to have Him close to us.

I had the honor and joy of spending time with the men who attended the retreat this weekend. I sincerely thank the Catholic Men's Fellowship for putting on this wonderful opportunity for our brothers to grow in their relationship with God, particularly through the working of the Holy Spirit. We need the Holy Spirit to be able to truly understand, humbly accept, and faithfully apply in our daily lives Christ's teaching. Through the intercession of our Mother Mary, let us remain docile to the Holy Spirit allowing Jesus' Word to fill us. We want to always be obedient to God's commandments so to have Him and His love in our hearts.






