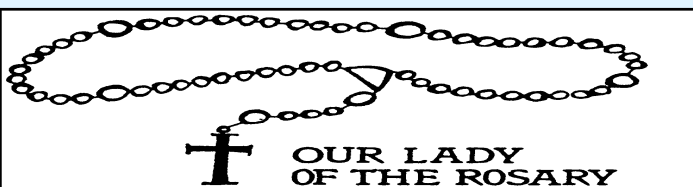

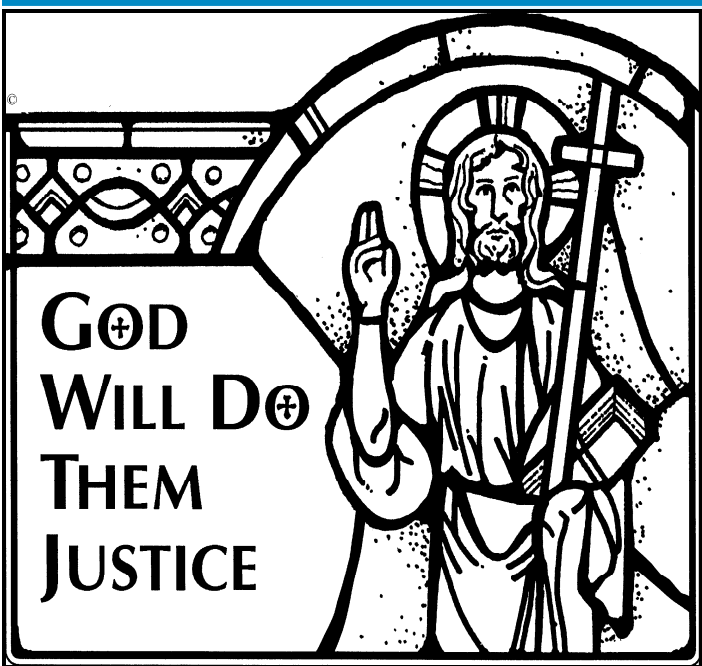

AM I A PARISHIONER OF ST. WILLIAM?

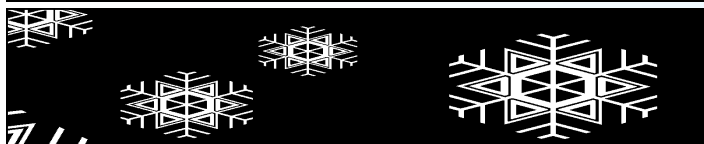

Wymóg ten dotyczy także osób, które jako dzieci były zapisane w parafii wraz z rodzicami, ale obecnie wyprowadziły się z domu i zamieszkują w innym miejscu.

Dlatego, aby właściwie móc planować życie naszej wspólnoty oraz uniknąć niepotrzebnych komplikacji w przygotowaniu do sakramentów tak często apelujemy o zapisywanie się do parafii.
