A MESSAGE FROM FR. JERRY

As our Nation celebrates Independence Day this weekend, it is fitting to consider the freedom which we have as the children of God. This follows from the freedom God gave to the Jewish people, which they remember each year as they celebrate Passover. God freed them from slavery, brought them out of the Land of Egypt and gave them their own land.
