A MESSAGE FROM FR. JERRY

Eucharistic etiquette is part of our expression of faith in the Real Presence of Jesus among us in this sacramental way. Jesus comes among us in the ultimate humility of appearing in our midst as bread and wine that we might enter into communion. When we acknowledge His Presence by faith, and even humble ourselves before Him here, we cannot fail to be blessed by Him. Expressions of faith and devotion include genuflecting before the Tabernacle of His Presence; observing the Communion fast of one hour from all food and drink (including candy & gum; excluding water and medicine); making a reverential bow before receiving Him; doing our best to participate fully in and follow closely the prayers of the Mass; dressing appropriately, as to present ourselves before someone of importance; but most important of all, to come to His Communion with pure hearts free of the stain of serious sin. We must not "condemn" Our Lord to additional pain and sorrow on account of our communion. Repent and be reconciled in Confession before going to Communion with serious sin. Let us do our best to honor and adore the Lord's Presence in our midst.

Eucharistic Adoration is an effective way of making reparation for offenses against the Lord. Usually, on the first Thursday of the month we have adoration during the day at St. Peter's following Mass at 7:30 A.M. until Benediction at 5:00 PM (this month it is this second week). To make the effort and sacrifice of coming to share in this adoration can be the source of many blessings and peace for the participants. Watch the bulletin for these special opportunities!

The Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary are special revelations of the Love which Jesus and Mary hold for us, their children. In each their hearts are seen aflame with love for humanity; but each also bear the thorns of pain caused by our indifference and offensive behaviors. We are called to console the hearts of Jesus and Mary by reparation for sins. This Friday is the Feast of the Sacred Heart: I will celebrate an additional Mass in Honor of the Sacred Heart at St. Peter's Friday at 5:30 PM. The feast of Mary's Immaculate Heart follows on Saturday, when I will celebrate a special Mass at St. Catherine's Saturday at 11:30 AM.

<u>Baptism</u> is the beginning of Christian Life. Come learn about this wonderful Sacrament and prepare for the Baptism of your child *Wednesday*, *June 10th* 7:00 PM at St. Catherine's Hall. Fr. Jerry will teach about this Sacrament, its place in our lives, and what it requires of parents, guardians and godparents.
