A MESSAGE FROM FR. JERRY

Pentecost!! The Birthday of the Church (Happy 1,982nd!), the coming of the Holy Spirit by which the Church comes alive: Three thousand are baptized that day! The difference is noticeable when the Holy Spirit comes alive in our lives. We no longer are afraid; we find new strength in our faith; we are able to proclaim the Good News of God's Love and show that love in our deeds, our works of mercy. I pray this Pentecost may bring a renewal and revival of your faith, a greater outpouring of the gifts of the Holy Spirit in your life, resulting in new works of love for all.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit, given for our sanctification are the following: the spirit of **Wisdom**, the prevision to look to your last end by cooperating now with the holy inspirations of God; the spirit of **Understanding**, that you might deepen your grasp of eternal truths; the spirit of **Counsel** to prudently choose the best way of pleasing God; the spirit of **Fortitude** to be able to stand up fearlessly in opposition to evil; the spirit of **Knowledge**, self-inspection regarding fidelity to God's laws and the duties of one's state in life; the spirit of **Piety** to enable you to prefer your Divine Lover and His will to earthly creatures; and the spirit of **Fear of the Lord**, to realize the folly and ingratitude of defying your Lord and God. **Pray for a greater outpouring of these gifts**, that you might grow in holiness of life and know the fruits of the Holy Spirit (see Galatians 6:22,23) in your life.

Memorial Day is observed on Monday. We remember our beloved dead, especially those who helped protect and defend the freedoms we enjoy at the cost of their lives. Our offices will be closed in this observance. MEMORIAL DAY FLOWERS

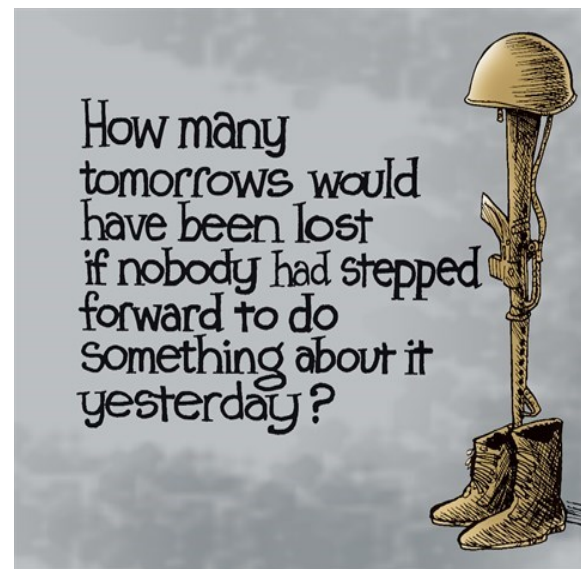
