



Pope Francis has described his vision of the Church as a field hospital in the middle of a terribly wounded world. The Church herself is populated by wounded and sinful members, but by God's grace she still serves as an instrument of healing and forgiving mercy.

During Lent 2015, the Church in the Archdiocese of Chicago wants to bring the medicine of mercy not only to the Catholic faithful but also to anyone who stands in need of healing and forgiveness.

Second Weekend in Lent


Across two days (Friday, February 27 and Saturday, February 28), the Church in Chicago will offer special opportunities for the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance and for prayers of healing. The Catholic faithful, especially those who have been away from the sacraments, are urgently invited to come and share in God's mercy. That second weekend of Lent, Paul's letter to the Romans will be read at every Mass. And we, the Church, will proclaim and embrace his words: "If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:11)

Everyone is Invited

Every human being lives with elements of brokenness. Every human soul knows its fragility. In Chicago, we are more aware than ever of the wounds inflicted on our city and its people by violence, gangs, drugs, domestic abuse, child neglect, economic injustice, and a spirit of mistrust among people of different races, cultures, languages, and ways of life. The city begs for the mercy of God and for healing. And the Catholic Church in Chicago wants to be a field hospital where all people can find the medicine of God's mercy.

Encounter God's Mercy

This focused time to encounter the mercy of God in our lives is inspired by Pope Francis who called the Church in Rome to a "Festival of Forgiveness," an annual Lenten observance to embrace God's mercy. In the Archdiocese of Chicago, we join our Holy Father and local churches throughout the world in their observance of this graced opportunity.

Wake Up

At a certain low point in the story of the now-destitute prodigal son, he **wakes up** to his situation. The text reads: "But when he came to himself, he said, 'How many of my father's hired hands have bread enough and to spare, but here I am dying of hunger! I will get up and go to my father'" (Luke 15:17–18)

In the Sacrament of Penance, we ask God for forgiveness that he gladly and generously gives to us. A very first step, however, is waking up to our situation and realizing how much we need God's mercy. The habits of sin may dull our minds and hearts. We may be sluggish in reflecting on our lives. Whatever numbs us must dissipate. We do need to wake up, and then with the prodigal son we can get up and go to our father.

Tell

We were probably very young at the time of our first confession. Inevitably, someone—a teacher or a parent—told us, "**Tell** your sins to the priest." Ever since that time, we may have been reluctant or we may have been relieved, but we have always known what we must do. We must tell our sins. Perhaps we have never quite grasped the reason for telling our sins. Actually, it's pretty simple.

When we tell our sins, we honestly own what we have done and what we have failed to do. When we tell our sins, we let them go into God's merciful hands. When we tell our sins, we acknowledge the next steps we must take, where we must go.

Finally, we understand. This is not about embarrassment. It's about freedom and change. And that is the work of God's grace.

Free Up

"The priest absolves your sins," the catechist tells her class of seven-year-olds. They accept it but, of course, don't understand it. Maybe some of us older folks don't quite get it either. The meaning behind this uncommon word is actually pretty simple. To absolve is to **free up**. We could use other words as well, such as to forgive, to unknot, to undo, or to release.

The great grace and result of the Sacrament of Penance is that sin no longer has a hold on us. What has trapped us and tied us up is dissipated. We find ourselves freed up. And the freedom we experience is genuine freedom, not just the freedom to do whatever we want but the real freedom to be who we truly are—God's beloved sons and daughters.

Repair

In the Sacrament of Penance, the priest offers what is called a "penance," usually a prayer or action. It is nothing severe or difficult to do. But don't think that it is of little importance. In fact, it's very important.

The penance is a small way to begin to **repair** the damage of sin. We confess our sins, and we receive absolution, the forgiveness of those sins. Still, the residue or consequences of sin remain. If we have been unjust or unkind, we need to repair the damage. If we have succumbed to habits that diminish us, we need to repair the damage. If we have ignored the needs of others, we need to repair the damage. The penance reminds us that a converted and forgiven heart will claim responsibility and then move forward. The penance may be a short prayer or a small action, but do not underestimate its value.

Despertarse

En la historia del hijo pródigo, el entonces indigente toca fondo y **despierta** ante su situación. El texto dice: "Entonces recapacitando pensó: A cuántos jornaleros de mi padre les sobra el pan mientras yo me muero de hambre. Me pondré en camino a casa de mi padre..." (Lucas 15:17).

En el sacramento de la Penitencia, le pedimos perdón a Dios y él nos lo da con alegría y generosidad. Un gran primer paso, sin embargo, es despertarnos ante nuestra situación y darnos cuenta de cuánto necesitamos de la misericordia de Dios. Los hábitos del pecado pueden ensordecer nuestra mente y nuestro corazón. Podemos ser lentos para reflexionar sobre nuestra vida. Sea lo que sea que nos adormeza debe desaparecer. Necesitamos despertar y, entonces, con el hijo pródigo, podemos ponernos en camino a casa de nuestro padre.

Dejar libre

"El sacerdote absuelve nuestros pecados", el catequista le dice a su clase de niños de siete años. Ellos lo aceptan pero, por supuesto, no lo comprenden. Tal vez algunos de nosotros los adultos, tampoco. El significado detrás de esta palabra poco común es en realidad muy simple. Absolver es **dejar libre**. También podríamos utilizar otras palabras como perdonar o desatar, o deshacer, o soltar.

Reparar

En el sacramento de la Penitencia, el sacerdote encomienda lo que se denomina "una penitencia", generalmente una oración o una obra. No es nada severo o difícil de hacer. Pero no debemos pensar que es de poca importancia. De hecho, es muy importante.

La penitencia es una manera simple de empezar a **reparar** el daño del pecado. Confesamos nuestros pecados y recibimos absolución, el perdón de estos pecados. No obstante, los residuos y las consecuencias del pecado permanecen. Si hemos sido injustos o poco amables, debemos reparar el daño. Si hemos sucumbido a hábitos que nos disminuyen, debemos reparar el daño. Si hemos ignorado las necesidades de los demás, debemos reparar el daño. La penitencia nos recuerda que un corazón convertido y perdonado pide responsabilidad y, luego, avanza. La penitencia puede ser una breve oración o una pequeña obra, pero no debemos subestimar su valor.

Week One – Tanzania

Like many farmers in Tanzania, Gertruda Domayo used to struggle to provide for her three grandchildren. Now she is a member of Soya ni Pesa, a Catholic relief Services project that means “soybeans are money”. Through the project, Gertruda has learned that a few small changes can make a big difference. Crop spacing and fertilizer have doubled her harvest. Membership in the local farmers’ group gets her good prices at market, which means a six fold increase in family income and the Soybeans themselves add nutrients to the soil, fueling future harvests. For Gertruda and her grandchildren, that means more and better food. Best of all, Gertruda knows how to provide her family with a better life.

Recipe from Tanzania: Ugali with bean soup

Makes 4-6 servings

UGALI

- 4 cups of water
- 2 1/2 cups of cornmeal

BEAN SOUP

- 1 small onion diced
- 1 green pepper diced
- 4 tbsp of olive oil
- 1 tsp of curry powder
- 1 tsp of salt
- 1/4 tsp of black pepper
- 1 tomato chopped
- 2 16oz cans of kidney beans drained
- 3 cups of unsweetened coconut milk

UGALI

Boil water in saucepan, then stir in cornmeal. Simmer until mixture is thick and water absorbed. Stir often to prevent burning. Shape the mixture into round balls, one for each person.

BEAN SOUP

In a large pot, saute onion and green pepper in oil until soft. Add curry powder, salt black pepper and tomato. Simmer for two minutes add beans and stir. Add coconut milk and simmer for ten minutes on low heat. Serve with Ugali.

Como muchos agricultores en Tanzania, Gertruda Domayo solia luchar para mantener a sus tres nietos. Ahora es miembro de soya ni Pesa, un proyecto de Cathilic Relief Services que significa “La soya es dinero”. Por medio de este proyecto, Gertruda a aprendido que algunos cambios pequeños pueden Hacer una gran diferencia. El separar las plantas de cultivo y los fertilizantes han duplicado sus cosechas. Ser miembros del grupo de agricultores locales le consigue buenos precios en el mercado para vender su cosecha, lo que significa un aumento de seis veces en el ingreso familiar, y las soyas en si, agregan nutrientes a la tierra, alimentando las cosechas futuras. Para Gertruda y sus nietos, eso significa mas y mejores alimentos. Lo mejor de todo es que Gertruda sabe como proveer a su familia una vida mejor.

Receta de Tanzania: Ugali con sopa de frijol

Rinde 4-6 porciones

UGALI

- 4 tazas de agua
- 2 1/2 tazas de harina de maíz

SOPA DE FRIJOL

- 1cebolla pequeña en cubos
- 1 pimiento verde en cubos
- 4 cucharadas de aceite de oliva
- 1 cucharadita de curry en polvo
- 1 cucharadita de sal
- 1/4 de cucharadita de pimienta negra
- Un tomate picado
- Dos latas de 454g (16oz) de habichuelas escurridas.
- 3 tazas de leche de coco sin azúcar
-

UGALI

Hervir el agua en una cacerola , añadir la harina de maíz. Cocinar a fuego lento hasta que la mezcla este espesa y el agua absorbida. Revuelva con frecuencia para evitar que se queme. Dividir la mezcla en bolas redondas, una para cada persona.

SOPA DE FRIJOLES

En una olla grande, saltear la cebolla y el pimiento verde en aceite hasta que estén blandos. Añadir el curry en polvo, la sal, la pimienta negra y el tomate. Cocinar a fuego lento por dos minutos. Agregar los frijoles y revolver. Añadir la leche de coco y cocinar por diez minutos a fuego lento. Servir con ugali.

Haznos caritativos para que seamos un reflejo de las obras que hacia Jesús para dar nuevas posibilidades a los pobres.


