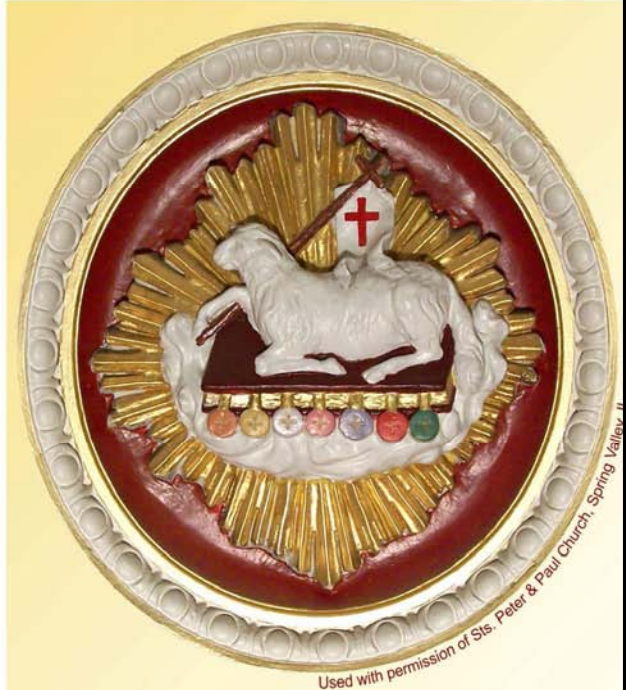

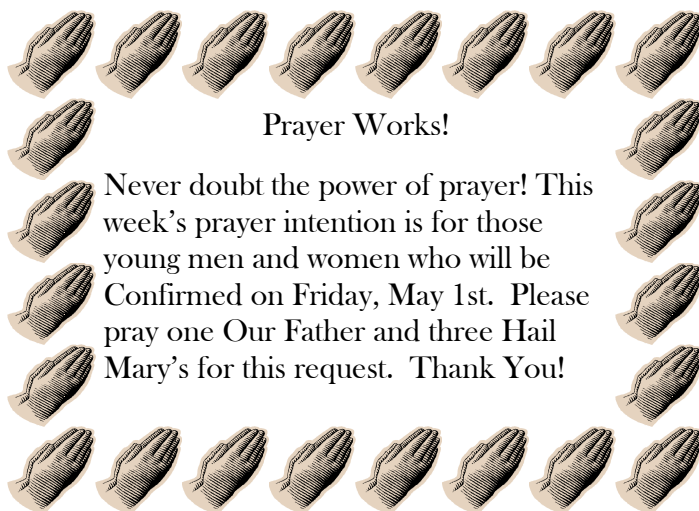

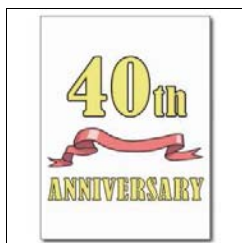

**Prayer for Vocations**



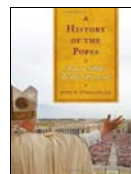
