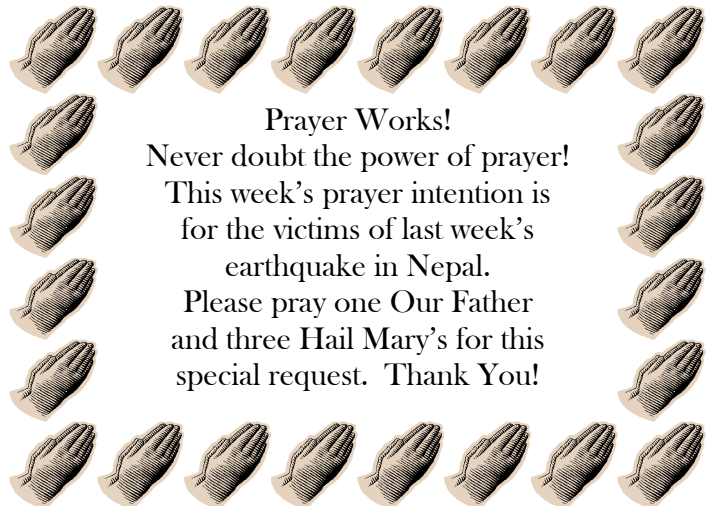

- 13— *Jesus filling thee with the Holy Spirit.*
- 14— *Jesus raising thee up.*
- 15— *Jesus crowning thee.*

**TWELVE HOUR - EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

The power of the Eucharist! The photo shows a wooden door of the convent in Assisi where Saint Claire lived and the Cross housed in the Church of Saint Damiano that spoke to Saint Francis during the thirteenth century. It was on a Friday in September in 1240 when Saracen troops entered the

city of Assisi and seized the convent. She, who was seriously ill at that time, had the sisters carry her to the chapel and she prayed to Christ in the tabernacle. After prostrating herself before the Lord, she spoke tearfully: 'Behold, my Lord, is it possible . . . protect these Your handmaids whom I cannot now save by myself.' Suddenly a voice . . . from the tabernacle said: *'I will always protect you!'* 'My Lord,' she added, 'if it is Your wish, protect also this city which is sustained by Your love.' Christ replied, *'It will!'* She rose and took hold of the Eucharist and appeared in that window. The Saracen troops stopped and their tracks and retreated. The convent and the city of Assisi were spared from attack.

On Friday, May 22nd, the parish will host a 12 Hour Eucharistic Adoration. The Adoration will begin with the 8:00 a.m. daily Mass and conclude with Benediction at 8:00 p.m. This week, there is a sign up sheet for you to select a half hour in which you would like to set aside time to adore Jesus present in the Blessed Sacrament. Bring any intention to Jesus and like Saint Claire be confident He will answer and protect you.

Eucharistic Adoration is every Saturday Morning following the 8:00 a.m. Community Mass. During Adoration, there is time for the Sacrament of confession and the praying of the Rosary. Please join us for this time of prayer and adoration!
