FROM THE PASTOR . . .


The days of Lent, that is our time of praying, fasting and almsgiving, are fast winding down. Next weekend we will be celebrating Palm Sunday and the start of Holy Week. This weekend in the gospel, we hear the story of the woman caught in adultery. The crowd wants to stone her according to Jewish law, but Jesus tells them, "Let the one without sin cast the first stone." In our own lives, how quick are we of accusing others of their sins and then missing the sins of our own life? Jesus' advice to us today is to take care of the faults in our own life, and allow God to handle the faults of others.

This week our Jubilee Year of Mercy focuses on the "sickness of sin". We need to realize that sin is a form of sickness. It can be a spiritual disease comparable to cancer or heart disease. In fact, spiritual diseases can be far more serious to our health than physical diseases. The corporal work of mercy this week is visiting the sick. We are not just talking about going to the hospital to visit a person on their sick bed; we are also talking about visiting a loved one or friend who is hurting spiritually or emotionally. We become sick when we yield to weakness or temptation in our daily lives. So then how are we able to cope in these difficult moments? It starts with prayer and our faith that our Lord, Jesus Christ, and our family and friends are with us guiding and supporting us to overcome these sins, these "spiritual diseases". In this Jubilee Year of Mercy, let us ask for mercy to help us overcome our sins.

Growing In Faith?: What sickness of sin do I need mercy for?


Corporal Work Of Mercy: Attend To The Sick -

This week our focus is on the sickness of sin in our lives. We are sick whenever we sin. This sickness is far more dangerous than any physical ailment could ever be. The Corporal Work of Mercy to Visit the Sick is not merely about going to the hospitals or visiting people on their sick bed. It is also about being there for anyone tempted to sin or vulnerable to the temptation to sin that is all around us. We are the sick when we yield to the weaknesses in our daily lives. How do we cope? First through prayer and faith but also through supporting and guiding each other. In this Jubilee Year of Mercy, we ask for mercy to help us begin again.
