Laudato Si' Encyclical —

The Good News People share from Pope Francis's encyclical, **Laudato Si**' (Praise Be to You). The encyclical is subtitled, *On Care for Our Common Home.*

Lack of housing is a grave problem in many parts of the world, both in rural areas and in large cities, since state budgets usually cover only a small

portion of the demand. Not only the poor, but many other members of society as well, find it difficult to own a home. Having a home has much to do with a sense of personal dignity and growth of families. This is a major issue for human ecology. (Paragraph 152)

The quality of life in cities has much to do with the systems of transport. Many cars circulate in cities causing traffic congestion, raising the level of pollution and consuming enormous quantities of nonrenewable energy. This makes it necessary to build more roads and parking areas which spoil the urban landscape. Many specialists agree on the need to give priority to public transportation. (Paragraph 153)


