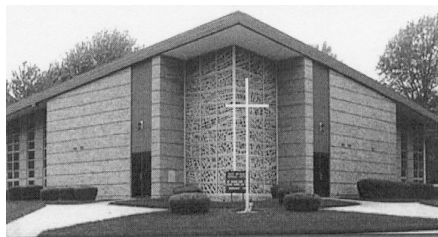

### FROM THE PASTOR . . .

In our gospel this weekend, we hear Jesus ask a very simple and direct question, "Who do you say that I am?" Apparently, there is a lot of speculation going on among the people who have come to hear Jesus speak. As they listen to him, they begin to wonder about his true identity. So in this passage today, Jesus asks his disciples who they think he is. As usual, it is Peter who gives the first answer to this question as he says, "You are the Messiah of God." Jesus then explains what is going to happen to him and tells them not to tell anyone else about his true identity.

The question that Jesus asked his disciples is also a question that he is asking us today. Who is Jesus for me? Is Jesus a very important person in my life? Does he make a difference in how I try to live out my life? Or, do I only think about Jesus on Sundays and then go about my daily business the rest of the week? What all these questions are really asking is whether Jesus is really important to me or not. How we answer those questions will indicate the direction in which we are living out our lives. Is it Christ-driven or is it self-driven?

Also this weekend we celebrate Father's Day. We need to remember that the role of the father in family life is very important. Fathers provide for their families. They are the person who makes it possible for us to enjoy the many blessing of life. So let us be good to our fathers on this special day. Thank you, fathers, for all you do for us, and may God bless you greatly on this your special day!

**Growing In Faith?: How do I look at my own Baptism?**

#### Laudato Si' Encyclical —

The Good News People present sections from the concluding chapters of Pope Francis's encyclical, **Laudato Si'** (Praise Be to You). The encyclical is subtitled, *On Care for Our Common Home*.

Doomsday predictions can no longer be met with irony or disdain. We may well be leaving to coming generations debris, desolation and filth. The pace of consumption, waste and environmental change has so stretched the planet's capacity that our contemporary lifestyle, unsustainable as it is, can only precipitate catastrophes, such as those which even now periodically occur in different areas of the world. The effects of the present imbalance can only be reduced by our decisive action, here and now. We need to reflect on our accountability before those who will have to endure the dire consequences.
