
MISSION STATEMENT

Help me, O Lord, that my eyes may be merciful, so that I may never suspect or judge from appearances, but look for what is beautiful in my neighbors' souls and come to their rescue. Help me, that my ears may be merciful, so that I may give heed to my neighbors' needs and not be indifferent to their pains and moanings. Help me, O Lord, that my tongue may be merciful, so that I should never speak negatively of my neighbor, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all . . . May your mercy, O Lord, rest upon me."

What can we learn from the Bible about families?

Five Lessons for Parents

The Bible is my favorite book. It provides deep moral auidelines, tells the history of the Israelites and witnesses to the Messiah, Jesus Christ. What it doesn't do is give parents a step by step set of instructions on how to raise their kids! There are some who try, but crossing the cultural boundaries over time is tricky. So just what do the Scriptures say to parents today? 1) Families are complicated. From Cain's jealousy which ends up as murder, to Abraham's infidelity that sets two mothers against one another it is easy to see that families are complex and far from perfect. Biblical families are characterized more by intrigue than wholesomeness. But there are important lessons. To these chaotic families God pledges loyalty and enduring presence — even amidst the jealousy, infidelity and thievery. These vices do not interfere with God's will, which often works in spite of our own efforts. (Adapted from Family *Bible Study* in this month's America magazine.)
