FROM THE PASTOR . . .

This weekend we hear the very familiar and popular story of the Good Samaritan. We are told of a gentleman who has been attacked by robbers, and that three different travelers came upon him. The first two travelers, a priest and then a Levite are very devout and religious Jewish figures, and yet, they offer no help or assistance to this gentleman. Then comes the third traveler a Samaritan, who is not Jewish, and he is the one who gives aid to this injured gentleman. At the conclusion of the story, Jesus asks the Jewish lawyer, "Which of these three persons was a neighbor to this victim?"

The Jewish lawyer seeks to justify himself before Jesus. He desires to know how he can inherit everlasting life. Jesus informs him that it is not enough to live by "The Golden Rule", but that one's love must be shared with the stranger as well as with one's neighbor. This is where the teaching of Jesus can become very difficult for us today. Like the lawyer, we often stumble in reaching out to the stranger or to the person who is different from us. Jesus is attempting to teach us that in reality there are no strangers, especially in his Father's Kingdom. In God's eyes, all of us are neighbors to each other, and we should be willing to give aid to any person no matter who they might be. Only by God's grace and love can we strive to be a neighbor to all humanity. May God help us all to be neighborly to one another.



Our new fiscal year began on July 1. The numbers listed above in our weekly tithing report represent contributions for the first weekend in our new fiscal year. To meet the tithing budget that was set by the finance council and approved by the pastoral council, our weekly need for 2016-2017 is \$7,308. As you can see, for the first weekend in the fiscal year, we were \$459 over the weekly need. This is our starting point for each weekend until next July 1. Each weekend's report will add to or subtract from this first \$459. You can watch each week to see how we are doing. In looking at the 2015-2016 budget, you donated 93.47% of what was needed to hit the budgeted amount for Sunday Collections. That is really close. Thanks, again, for your generosity to your parish.

What can we learn from the Bible about families?

Five Lessons for Parents

The Gospel challenges families. The vocation of the family is inwardly directed toward its members and outwardly directed towards mission in the world. Even though it is difficult to get uncooperative children and teens to church consistently, it is the vocation of the family to engage in meaningful work toward the social good. In the Gospels, Jesus clearly and repeatedly rejects commonly held familial obligations. At times he pits true discipleship and family allegiance against one another. But Jesus wants us to realize to whom we are loyal. St. John Chrysostom wrote that parents are to educate and raise Christian children, not because they are bound by biological ties, but because Christians are called to serve their neighbors. Children are simply the parents' closest neighbor in need! Scripture suggests that when families become too inwardly focused (busy schedules, etc.) they are failing their Christian obligations and failing to be Christian families. 


