Mark is telling us that Jesus came into the world to bring healing to the sick and to proclaim the coming of God's Kingdom. We need to keep in mind that what Jesus did in this story is something that he can and does for us today. Even two thousand years later, Jesus shares his healing love for us through the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Countless sick people know the experience of Jesus' healing touch because they have received this very special sacrament. When we are sick, may we invite Jesus' healing love to touch our lives.

This weekend we celebrate Labor Day. For most of us, this weekend represents the end of summer and the beginning of fall. I hope that you have an enjoyable and lovely Labor Day, and let us all enjoy the last days of summer and look forward with hope for a pleasant and lovely fall.

#### Laudato Si' Encyclical —

The Good News People share from Pope Francis's encyclical, **Laudato Si** (Praise Be to You). The encyclical is subtitled, *On Care for Our Common Home*.

Pope Saint John XXIII said in Evangelii Guadium, "I would like to enter into dialogue with all people about our common home." From Pacem in Terris, Blessed Pope Paul VI referred to the ecological concern as a tragic consequence of unchecked human activity. St. John Paul II warned in his first encyclical that human beings frequently seem to see no other meaning in their natural environment than what served for immediate use and consumption. St. John Paul II called for a global ecological conversion. Pope Benedict XVI proposed eliminating the structural cause of the dysfunctions of the world economy and correcting models of growth which have proved incapable of ensuring respect for the environment.
