FROM THE PASTOR . . .

Today's reading from the gospel is the second of three passion predictions found in the ninth chapter of Mark's gospel. According to Mark, Jesus went willingly to his death. By his willingness, Jesus proved the quality of his relationship with God, as well as his personal character and his belief in immortality.

What is striking in each of these passion predictions is that Jesus' disciples do not grasp the point, and they seem to misunderstand Jesus totally. In this second passion prediction, the disciples appear more concerned with discussing who was the greatest among themselves. In correcting this misunderstanding, Jesus reminds them that to follow him they will find that true greatness is found in service to others and not in their own personal stature. Jesus himself is the best example of his own ideal of servant leadership. We see this in his teachings on how to relate to his Heavenly Father. We see this in his healings as he brought both physical and spiritual well-being to those in need. And in his passion, death and resurrection Jesus opened up the possibility for us to have a correct relationship with God the Father. Today, Jesus teaches us that he, the servant leader, is the opposite of the world's leaders who are typically motivated by personal ambition and petty jealousy.

Growing In Faith?: How willing am I to help others?




