FROM THE PASTOR . . .

This weekend is Respect Life Sunday. For many years, the bishops of America have declared that the month of October is the time of year in which we reaffirm the dignity of all human life. Jesus tells us today in the gospel, "Whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God like a child, shall not enter into it." We are being reminded today of the importance of a sense of wonder and awe. We need the ability to find and appreciate God's presence in all of life. To wonder is to see the mystery and marvel of God's handiwork all around us.

Throughout this month of October, we will sing one verse of a Marian hymn at the time of meditation after communion. We will use this hymn as a means for praying for a greater respect for the sanctity and dignity of all life by asking the Blessed Mother to help us to see God's presence in all creation. Please join our efforts to respect life.

Finally, this week the priests of the Des Moines Diocese will be away in Ames for our annual fall workshop. The topic for this week is the new evangelization. In my absence, Deacon Jim will lead a communion service on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. If there should be a funeral or medical emergency, I will come back from the workshop. I'm looking forward to a pleasant workshop. May parish life remain fairly quiet during my absence.

Growing In Faith?: Do I still have a sense of wonder in my life?

Laudato Si´ Encyclical — The Good News People share from Pope Francis's encyclical, **Laudato Si**´ (Praise Be to You). The encyclical is subtitled, *On Care for Our Common Home*.

Pope Francis continues to quote Patriarch Bartholomew by asking us "to replace consumption with sacrifice, greed with generosity, wastefulness with a spirit of sharing, an asceticism which entails learning to give, and not simply to give up." He continues, "As Christians we are called to accept the world as a sacrament of communion, as a way of sharing with God and our neighbors on a global scale. It is our humble conviction that the divine and the human meet in the slightest detail in the seamless garment of God's creation, in the last speck of dust on our planet."




