#### FROM THE PASTOR . . .

One of the greatest challenges we face in life is the tension between faith and personal wealth. Is our primary pursuit in life to possess wealth or is it to have a loving relationship with the Lord? The gospel this weekend addresses this fundamental question with the story of the rich man and Jesus. We are told that the rich man is very much impressed by the teaching of Jesus and he wants to know more about eternal life. Immediately, Jesus asks him if he is following the Ten Commandments. The rich man answers yes, that he has obeyed them since his youth. Then Jesus drops the proverbial bomb by saying, "Then do one more thing. Go sell what you have, give it to the poor, and then come follow me." To which the man leaves Jesus feeling very sad for himself because he can not sell off his riches.

Does this story mean that Jesus is condemning wealth? Yes and no; it's a little of both. We must be careful not to take this story too literally. We need to remember that in ancient Judaism wealth was understood as a blessing from God. The prevailing thought of the day was that the more wealth a person had, the more blessed that person was and the closer they were to God. In this story, Jesus appears to refute this accepted belief of his day. So Jesus is not directly condemning wealth, but he is condemning those persons who put their wealth ahead of God. Jesus gives the rich man an opportunity to follow him, but the rich man is not capable of giving up his wealth to follow the Lord. This is the reason the rich man sadly leaves Jesus. He can not put his love of God ahead of his wealth. Consequently, Jesus feels sorry for the rich man and he remarks, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the Kingdom of God."

**Growing In Faith?**: Do I put wealth ahead of the Lord?

**Laudato Si´ Encyclical** — The Good News People share from Pope Francis's encyclical, **Laudato Si´** (Praise Be to You). The encyclical is subtitled, *On Care for Our Common Home*.

Pope Francis spends three chapters on the teachings of St. Francis of Assisi who he took as his name and guide. "I believe that Saint Francis is the example par excellence of care for the vulnerable and of an integral ecology lived out joyfully and authentically. Just as happens when we fall



in love with someone, whenever he would gaze at the sun, moon or the smallest of animals, he burst into song, drawing all other creatures into his praise. Saint Francis, faithful to Scripture, invites us to see nature as a magnificent book in which God speaks to us and grants us a glimpse of His infinite beauty and goodness. Rather than a problem to be solved, the world is a joyful mystery to be contemplated with gladness and praise."
