
MISSION STATEMENT

FROM THE PASTOR . . .

Last weekend, we were reintroduced to the person of John the Baptist. We heard his message to repent. This weekend, we continue to hear more about John. We are told in today's gospel that the crowds are curious to learn whether he might finally be the long promised Messiah. Sadly, for the crowds, John assures them that he is not the Messiah, but that one mightier than he is coming. In fact, he is very close at hand.

This Third Sunday of Advent is also known as "Gandete Sunday" which is Latin and means "praise" or "rejoice." Gandete Sunday marks the halfway point of our Advent journey to Christmas. As this great day is fast approaching, the church wants us to be filled with a spirit of praise and rejoicing. This is why we light the pink candle on the Advent wreath. It informs us that we are now half way on our journey to celebrating the birth of our Savior.

As we make ready for the coming of Christmas, it is good that we heed John the Baptist's call to repentance. This Wednesday evening we will be celebrating our Advent Healing/Reconciliation Service. It is very similar to the service we celebrated in Lent last March. I hope that you will make every effort to have your sins be forgiven in this special and powerful experience of healing and reconciliation. Allow this experience to bring peace into your hearts this Christmas.

Apostolic Exhortation "The Joy of Love" -

(from the 2014/2015 Assembly of the Synod of Bishops)

A family's living space could turn into a domestic church, a setting for the Eucharist, the presence of Christ seated at its table. We can never forget the image found in the Book of Revelation where the Lord says, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If any one hears my voice and opens the door, I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me. " (Rev. 3:20) Here we see a home filled with the presence of God, common prayer, and every blessing. This is the meaning of the conclusion of Psalm 128 which uses the imagery drawn from the building of a house and social life of cities. The family is thus the place where parents become their children's first teachers in the faith. They learn this "trade", passing it down from one person to another.
