Apostolic Exhortation "The Joy Of Love" — (from the 2014/2015 Assembly of Synod of Bishops)



— excerpt from Chapter 1, p. 35 Love is so central to the Christian

experience of marriage and the family. Another virtue stands out, one often overlooked in our world of frenetic and superficial relationships. It is tenderness. In Psalm 131, Exodus 4:22, Isaiah 49:15, and Psalm 27:10, the union between the Lord and his faithful ones is expressed in terms of parental love. Here we see a delicate and tender intimacy between mother and child: the image is that of a baby sleeping in his mother's arms after being nursed. As the Hebrew word "gamul" suggests, the infant is now fed and clings to his mother, who takes him to her bosom. There is a closeness that is conscious and not simply biological. Drawing on this image, the Psalmist sings: "I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a child quieted at its mother's breast (Psalm 131:2)

What a timely image of tenderness this Christmas Season!






