FROM THE PASTOR . . .


On this Second Sunday of Advent, we are once again introduced to the person of John the Baptist. John is the herald in the desert who the prophets of old had foretold would come to prepare the way of the Lord. As we heard in today's gospel, his message was direct and blunt, "Reform your lives! The reign of God is at hand." What we need to realize today is that this message is as much directed towards us as it was the people of John's day.

The entire purpose of the Advent season is to make ready for the coming of the Lord, whenever that fateful day may come. The simplest and most effective way to do this is by confessing our sins. This past Wednesday evening, at St. Mary's Church in Panama was the first of two celebrations of the Healing and Reconciliation Services. The next celebration will occur here at St. Michael's on Wednesday evening, December 14, at 6:30 p.m. This will be very similar to the Healing and Reconciliation Service we did last Lent. We will once again use the sacrament of the anointing of the sick to celebrate spiritual healing (that is forgiveness of sins) along with physical and emotional healing. There will again be stations for private reconciliation at the conclusion of the healing service. Let us take advantage of this opportunity to have our sins forgiven during this Advent season. May the peace of Jesus Christ come into your hearts this Advent.

The very words "to be joined" or "to cleave" in the original Hebrew, bespeak a profound harmony, a closeness both physical and interior, to such an extent that the word is used to describe our union with God. The marital union is thus evoked not only in its sexual and corporal dimensions, but also in its voluntary self-giving in love. The result of this union is that the two "become one flesh" both physically and in the union of their hearts and lives, and eventually in a child who will share not only genetically but also spiritually in the "flesh" of both parents.
