Perhaps you are not yet baptized, or baptized in another Christian tradition. The upcoming sessions are also for adults who have not been Confirmed or have not received First Communion.


The RCIA process has begun and continues until spring. This commitment is an opportunity to learn with others, to share, and to grow in faith. Find what you may be missing.
