SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This sacrament, best celebrated when the community gathers for worship, is scheduled November 11/12 at each Mass. It is intended for Catholics over the age of 7, the traditional 'age of reason', whose lives are disrupted by: accident or illness, chronic or acute, physical or psychological; or upcoming surgery.

As one of the seven sacraments it employs the use of oil, a medicinal agent in ancient times. This sacrament celebrates God's desire and the hope of the Catholic community that the recipient either return to health and/or live well despite the illness or accident.
